Advanced Asphalt Co., Successor in Interest to LaSalle County Asphalt, by Michael L. English, its Attorney, pursuant to the Rules of Practice of the Illinois Commerce Commission ("the Commission"), 83 Ill. Admin. Code 200.200, Petition for Leave to Intervene and to be made a participant in the above captioned proceeding. In support of the Petition, Advanced Asphalt Co. states the following:

1. Attorney Michael L. English represents Advanced Asphalt Co., before this Commission.
2. Advanced Asphalt Co., as landowner will be affected by any order entered by the Commission in this proceeding.
3. Advanced Asphalt Co. possesses ownership interests in certain parcels of real estate located in LaSalle County, Illinois that fall within and/or directly adjacent to the primary route Ameren has selected for the proposed LaSalle-Wedron Line.
4. Advanced Asphalt Co. has an interest in the subject matter of this proceeding and will be directly and materially affected by the construction of the LaSalle-Wedron Line as currently proposed.
5. Petitioner believes that a reasonable attempt to negotiate with landowner due to an overburdening easement and unjust compensation for said easement was not made.

6. Advanced Asphalt Co. is aware that Section 200.200(e) of the Commission's rules of practice provides that an intervenor shall accept the status of the record as it exists at the time of the intervenor's intervention.


