MOTION TO WITHDRAW


COMES NOW, ConocoPhillips Company ("COP") through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.190, moves the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") to withdraw ConocoPhillips Company's previously filed Application for Certificate of Service Authority ("Application").

1. On June 10, 2010, COP filed an Application pursuant to 83 Ill. Adm. Code 551 and Section 19-110 of the Public Utilities Act. In its Application, COP requested that the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority offer competitively priced natural gas to Commercial and Industrial customers.
2. On June 22, 2010, COP was notified, that pursuant to 220 ILCS 5/19-105 and Part 551, its Application was not necessary as long as COP does not provide or plan to provide service to small commercial customers or residential customers which use less than 5,000 therms per year.
3. COP does not intend to offer natural gas service to customers consuming less than 5,000 therms per year. Therefore, COP's Application is not required.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, ConocoPhillips Company moves the Illinois Commerce Commission to grant its Motion to Withdraw its Application for Certificate of Service Authority.


