DU PAGE COUNTY EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD'S

PETITION TO INTERVENE

DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board (DuPage ETSB) seeks to intervene and participate as a party in this docket. In support thereof, DuPage County ETSB states as follows:

1. DuPage County ETSB is a statutorily appointed board duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Illinois. DuPage County ETSB provides 9-1-1 service to the residents of DuPage County and portions of Cook County, Kane County and Will County.
2. The DuPage County ETSB entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Burr Ridge Emergency Telephone System Board on February 26, 1991. (JPS-003-91, and subsequently amended on August 10, 1999, JPS-003A-91.)
3. According to the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement dated August 10, 1999, Paragraph 5 – Computation of Surcharge, Burr Ridge ETSB shall submit 50¢ per telephone access line in Burr Ridge based on the August 1 line count plus or minus an additional 15¢ for each access line over or under the August 1 access line count. The monthly surcharge for Alternative Local Exchange carriers shall be 50¢ based on actual number of access lines.
4. On July 26, 2000 the Village of Burr Ridge notified the DuPage ETSB that the Village of Burr Ridge intends to withdraw from membership in the DuPage County ETSB effective April 30, 2001.
5. The DuPage County ETSB has received payments from Burr Ridge through and including January 31, 2001, received April 3, 2001. The DuPage County ETSB has expended and will expend monies to pay for monthly network expenses due and owing Ameritech through and including April 30, 2001.


6. The DuPage County ETSB seeks an order from the ICC ordering the Village of Burr Ridge and the Burr Ridge ETSB to pay all funds due and owing the DuPage County ETSB through and including April 30, 2001. Said monies due and owing shall be in full compliance with the terms of Intergovernmental Agreement JPS-003A-91.
7. DuPage County ETSB also seeks continuing financial support for the Tri-State Fire Protection District which services fifty percent (50%) geographically of residences and businesses in the Village of Burr Ridge. DuPage County ETSB funds the 9-1-1 operation at Tri-State Fire Protection District and is requesting the ICC to enter an order for the Burr Ridge ETSB to pay the DuPage County ETSB fifty percent (50%) of the 9-1-1 surcharge at the rate of sixteen cents (.16¢) per line.
8. Copies of all pleadings, notices and correspondence in this proceeding should be sent to the undersigned.






