**IL, IN, and OH**

(1) SCC will accept the published UNE rates (for 911 services) for IL, IN and OH, provided that those are the rates charged and billed to other CLECs in those states. So that SCC will be treated in parity with other CLECs, we request SBC's confirmation that other CLECs in IL, IN and OH also pay those rates. If not, please provide copies of pricing appendices from CLEC interconnection agreements in those states so that we may assess pricing (in order to maintain confidentiality, feel free to redact the CLEC names).

<p>The UNE rates raise a number of questions. First, is the DBMS service per 100 records or per 1000 records? If the former, those rates are extraordinarily steep. We discussed this apparent discrepancy several weeks ago, but as of yet, SBC has not clarified the issue.</p>	<p>It is per 100 records. This is stated in the cost studies.</p>

<p>Second, will the rates for transport from SCC's POP to the POI come from SWBT's special access tariffs in IL, IN, and OH? If so, there appear to be duplicative charges between the access tariffs and the published UNE rates. Specifically, the access tariffs include channel termination rates and the published UNE rates include charges for digital DS1 interface and channel interface. In addition, the access tariffs and the published UNE rates charge installation fees. Please confirm that SCC would not be forced to pay twice for essentially the same service element.</p>

<p>Please also confirm that the charges associated with 911 selective routing switch administration will apply only once and not for every subsequent connection of service at a particular selective routing tandem.</p>	<p>This statement is true.</p>

<p>As you know, the WI tariffed rates are very similar to the published UNE rates in IL, IN and OH. Thus, we request the same clarifications for the WI pricing scheme.</p>	<p>Addressed above.</p>

**(4) TX, OK, and KS**

First, please confirm that the rates include electronic access to the MSAG and please confirm the frequency of MSAG updates.	Yes, referenced in Addendum I

Second, please confirm that the rates include the ability to compare database records that reside in the FRDBMS.	Since the FRDBMS is the database of the customer, this is SCC's responsibility.

Fourth, please confirm that the E911 Trunk rates include transport and termination to and from SCC's POP.	This is not a true statement.

(5) We were unable to locate tariffs, published UNEs, or X2A-type agreements for AR, MO, MI, or NV. Obviously, CLECs do business in those states, so there must be pricing somewhere. It appears, however, that such pricing is only at SBC's disposal. We ask that SBC provide representative pricing appendices from interconnection agreements with CLECs (with names redacted, if you wish) in those states so that we may assess pricing. Of course, if SBC does not charge or bill CLECs for 911 services in those states, SCC expects similar treatment.	Rates found.

(6) We were unable to locate tariff or UNE pricing in any of SBC's 13 states for ALI Steering/Dynamic ALI Update. Again, wireless carriers obviously do business in SBC's territory, so there must be pricing somewhere. It appears, however, that such pricing is only at SBC's disposal. We ask that SBC provide representative pricing appendices from interconnection agreements with wireless carriers (with names redacted, if you wish) in each of the 13 states so that we may assess pricing. Again, if SBC does not charge or bill for such services, SCC expects similar treatment.
