SOUTHWEST CENTRAL 9-1-1 SYSTEM'S AND SOUTHWEST CENTRAL DISPATCH'S
MOTION TO DISMISS DU PAGE COUNTY EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM
BOARD'S PETITION TO INTERVENE**

Comes now the DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board and files its Response to Southwest Central 9-1-1 System's and Southwest Central Dispatch's Motion to Dismiss DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board's Petition to Intervene. The DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board moves that the Illinois Commerce Commission deny Southwest Central 9-1-1 System's and Southwest Central Dispatch's Motion to Dismiss DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board's Petition to Intervene. In support thereof, DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board states as follows:

1. Southwest Central 9-1-1 System and/or Southwest Central Dispatch does not have standing to oppose DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board's Petition to Intervene. Southwest Central 9-1-1 System and/or Southwest Central Dispatch allege that the Village of Burr Ridge has entered into Intergovernmental Agreements with Southwest Central 9-1-1 system and Southwest Central Dispatch. Any agreements entered into by the Village of Burr Ridge and

Southwest Central 9-1-1 system and Southwest Central Dispatch are prospective in nature. Until the Village of Burr Ridge has an order to operate a 9-1-1 system, Southwest Central 9-1-1 System and/or Southwest Central Dispatch do not have any interest in the existing arrangement between the Village of Burr Ridge and the DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board. .


2. Southwest Central 9-1-1 System and/or Southwest Central Dispatch have not filed the proper petitions to intervene in this matter and therefore are precluded from incorporating the Village of Burr Ridge's Motion to Dismiss the DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board's Petition to Intervene, as well as the Village of Burr Ridge's supplemental Motion to Dismiss DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board's Petition to Intervene.

3. Southwest Central 9-1-1 System and/or Southwest Central Dispatch have not filed the proper petitions to intervene in this matter and therefore are precluded from incorporating the pleadings filed by the Illinois Commerce Commission's Staff in opposition to the DuPage County Emergency Telephone System's Board's Petition to Intervene.

The DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board respectfully requests that the Illinois Commerce Commission deny Southwest Central 9-1-1 System's and Southwest Central Dispatch's Motion to Dismiss DuPage County Emergency Telephone System Board's Petition to Intervene.




