## **Narrative Statement**

The Alsip Police Department 9-1-1 Center currently handles all police, fire & emergency medical service calls for the Village of Alsip and the Village of Crestwood.

We are in the process of omitting, with Illinois Commerce Commission approval, the Village of Crestwood, which has current plans to join the Southwest Central Dispatch system. The Village of Alsip is also seeking leave to dismiss the authority of the Joint ETSB established under Illinois Commerce Commission Docket #09-0003 and re-establish the Alsip ETSB that was in place prior to the agreement between the Village of Alsip and the Village of Crestwood. The Village of Crestwood would then join the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System by means of an intergovernmental agreement.

Intergovernmental Agreement #878-08, entered into by the Villages of Alsip and Crestwood, states in Section 10.2, "This agreement may be terminated by either party by providing ninety (90) days written notice of termination to the other party." This condition was satisfied when the Village of Crestwood notified the Village of Alsip of its intent to transfer dispatching responsibility to Southwest Central Dispatch.

On August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010, the Village of Alsip adopted Ordinance #2010-8-2 which suspends operations of the Joint ETSB and resumes operation of the Alsip ETSB.

The Village of Alsip will continue to handle dispatching duties for the Alsip Police Department and Alsip Fire Department and its 9-1-1 system will function in same manner as it did prior to the Village of Crestwood joining the system.

ORDINANCE 2010-8-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 ("ADMINISTRATION"),  
ARTICLE XI ("EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SYSTEM BOARD"), DIVISION 2 ("911  
EMERGENCY"), SECTION 2-211 ("COMBINED DISPATCH-JOINT BOARD") OF THE  
MUNICIPAL CODE FOR THE VILLAGE OF ALSIP

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Alsip, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of their home rule powers, as follows:

**SECTION 1. Village Code Amended.** Chapter 2 ("Administration"), Article XI ("Emergency Telephone System Board"), Division 2 ("911 Emergency"), Section 2-211 ("Combined Dispatch-Joint Board") of the Municipal Code for the Village of Alsip is hereby amended by deleting the overstricken language and adding the underlined to read as follows:

**Sec. 2-211. Combined dispatch-Joint board.**

Suspension of the Combined Dispatch-Joint Board Alsip ETSB; Transfer of Alsip ETSB Funds to the Joint ETSB to the Village's emergency telephone system Board. The Alsip ETSB combined dispatch-joint board shall suspend operating as an emergency telephone system board as of the date the ICC permits the joint emergency telephone system board of the Villages of Alsip and Greenwood village's emergency telephone system board to operate as a joint emergency telephone system board resumes operations pursuant to section 2-195 of sec. of this Code as amended. In addition, prior to its suspension, the Alsip ETSB combined dispatch-joint board shall also issue an order transferring all surcharge funds under its control to the joint board Village's emergency telephone system board. The Alsip ETSB shall not operate as an emergency telephone system board unless and until the Village of Alsip terminates its membership with the joint board and receives the approval of the ICC as evidenced by an Order of the ICC to once again operate as an emergency telephone system board and receive surcharge funds collected pursuant to the Village of Alsip 911 surcharge referendum.

**SECTION 2. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as provided by law.
