STAFF'S ANSWER TO THE PETITION

Now comes the Staff of the Illinois Commerce Commission (Staff) and in support of its Answer to Southwest Central 9-1-1 System's Petition for Approval of Modifications to Existing 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone Numbering System, states the following:


1. Southwest Central 9-1-1 System received an initial order to operate its Enhanced 9-1-1 System from the Commission on March 18, 1992, in Docket 92-0069.
2. On October 27, 2010, Southwest Central 9-1-1 System filed a Petition for Approval of Modifications to an Existing 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System in which it requests to incorporate the Village of Crestwood into its 9-1-1 system upon receipt of a Final Order from this Commission.
3. Currently, all 9-1-1 calls for the Village of Crestwood are handled by the Alsip 9-1-1 System. In Docket 10-0617, also filed on October 27, 2010, the Alsip 9-1-1 System is requesting to opt the Village of Crestwood out of its 9-1-1 system due to Crestwood's' desire to join the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System.
4. The Village of Crestwood has passed an ordinance authorizing its intergovernmental agreement with and entry into the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System.
5. Staff has thoroughly reviewed Southwest Central 9-1-1 System's Petition for Approval of Modifications to Existing 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone Numbering System and supports the petitioners' request for modification. In addition, Staff supports waiving a hearing in this docket.




