

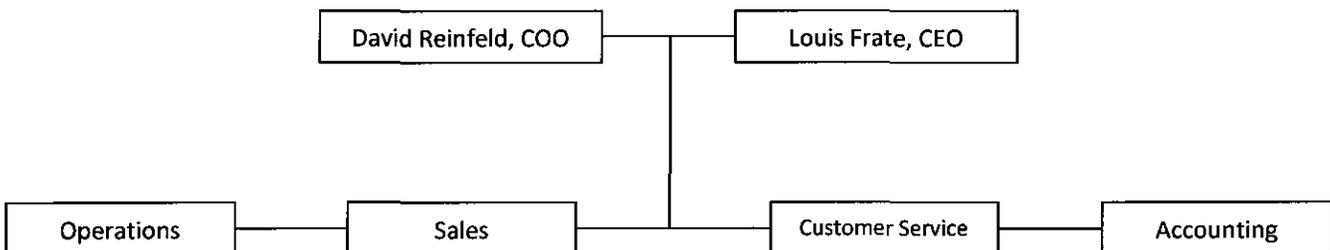

Patriot Energy Group, Inc. was founded in 2002 and provides energy supply brokerage services to commercial and industrial customers in deregulated markets. The company is co-owned and managed by Louis Frate and David Reinfeld.

Louis Frate, CEO: Louis co-founded Patriot Energy in 2002 and as the Chief Executive Officer his responsibilities include product development, marketing, and customer service. Prior to co-founding Patriot Energy, Louis was most recently a VP of Southeast Sales for a publically traded telecommunications firm. In that position, his responsibilities included the management of \$72 million in annual revenue while overseeing the hiring and training of a staff of 200 in multiple states. He was also responsible for overseeing allocation and logistics for three Voice and Data Switching and Storage Co-location Facilities in Miami, FL, Orlando, FL and Norcross, GA. Louis has a BS in Business Management from Merrimack College.

David Reinfeld, COO: David co-founded Patriot Energy in 2002. He has overseen the successful placement of over 750 MWs of customer accounts onto competitive supply in retail markets. As COO, David is responsible for overseeing the pricing analysis from the competitive suppliers during our bid process and ensuring that our back office works to complete enrollment of our customers into the supply program. Prior to co-founding Patriot Energy, he was a director at Enron, with a decade of experience in power & natural gas. He helped to structure successful wholesale and retail transactions in the Northeast (NEPOOL) and Mid-Atlantic (PJM) wholesale power markets and successfully developed a 500 MW integrated power and gas pipeline investment in Brazil and Bolivia. David holds a Bachelor's degree from the University of Rochester and a Master's Degree from Tufts Fletcher School of Law and Diplomacy.

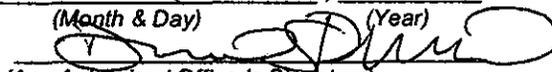
