ILLINOIS POWER COMPANY'S
1999 MGP ACTIVITIES VENDORS AND CONSULTANTS

In 1999, Illinois Power Company (Company) employed the following vendors and consultants to provide services in support of its MGP remedial management plan. The basis for the selection of each is also provided below.

Beelman Trucking	Provided hauling services for cleanup waste and waste treatment materials. Beelman was chosen by competitive bid.
Don Jones Excavation	Periodic mowing and other site maintenance work is required at the Cairo MGP. Based upon recommendations of the Cairo Municipal Utility, Mr. Jones was selected. In addition, use of Mr. Jones negates many logistical concerns since he has a working relationship with the Cairo Public Utility.
C. Grantham Company	Material hauling for activities at various MGP sites. Grantham was chosen by competitive bid.
Digital Video Imagery	Provided video production services for preparation of a video to be used for community relations activities prior to MGP excavations.
Heritage Laboratories, Inc.	Analytical services in support of MGP activities. Initially, this company was selected based upon competitive bidding. Year-to-year renewal of this contract is based upon demonstration of technical abilities, passing of the

Company's audit/due diligence process, and review of the negotiated prices relative to prices quoted by other qualified laboratories.

Illinova Generation

Processing of MGP wastes at the Baldwin Thermal Treatment facility.

Monti Communications

Provided community relations support at MGP facilities. This support is instrumental in the success of the Company's program and acceptance of the remedial solutions in communities. Monti Communications was selected based upon experience, credibility with the regulatory community, proximity to sites, and competitive rates. Monti Communications is a Certified Female Business Enterprise under the State of Illinois Central Management Services Business Enterprise Program for Minorities, Females and Persons with Disabilities.

Philip Environmental Services

Philip serves as the Company's principal consultant for MGP activities. The company was chosen originally by competitive bid. In 1996, the Company entered into an alliance contract with Philip. The alliance was tested by competitively bidding the Cairo IRM project in 1996 and it was tested again in 1997 by bidding the Belleville IRM project.

State of Illinois

Reimbursement for charges for Illinois EPA oversight of the Company's MGP program.

Teklab

Provided analytical services in support of MGP activities. Year-to-year renewal of this contract is based upon demonstration of technical abilities, passing of the Company's audit/due diligence process, and review of the negotiated prices relative to prices quoted by other qualified laboratories.

Waste Management of Illinois -
(WMI - Milam Landfill)

Disposal of MGP wastes. The selection was based on the proximity to the site, ability to solidify wastes, and an existing blanket order for the company. The unit cost provided by WMI was within the norm for the area. The selection of WMI also resulted in the shortest distance for transportation. Transportation is a major component in remedial costs. WMI was tested by the Company's auditing/due diligence process.
