Notice of Administrative Law Judge's Ruling

Notice is hereby given that the Administrative Law Judge has completed a preliminary review of the application filed by North Shore Energy Consulting, LLC ("Applicant") in Docket No. 10-0678, and hereby rules that a verified response, containing the information and clarifications described below, shall be filed with the Commission.

If filed electronically via the Commission's e-docket system, this verified response shall be filed with the Chief Clerk of the Commission on or before January 28, 2011. If the filing is made by non-electronic means, then January 28, 2011 is a mailing date. Applicant shall serve a copy of its response on the Administrative Law Judge (syoder@icc.illinois.gov). For purposes of doing so, January 29, 2011 is a receipt or "in hand" date, not later than 5:00 P.M., by electronic mail, Fax (217-524-8928) or otherwise.

Section 454.80 Financial Licensing Requirements

Section 454.80 provides as follows:

a) The applicant shall execute and maintain a license or permit bond issued by a qualifying surety or insurance company authorized to transact business in the State of Illinois in favor of the People of the State of Illinois. The amount of the bond shall equal \$5,000. The bond shall be conditioned upon the full and faithful performance of all duties and obligations of the applicant as an ABC and shall be valid for a period of not less than one year. The cost of the bond shall be paid by the applicant. The applicant shall file this bond as part of its application for certification.

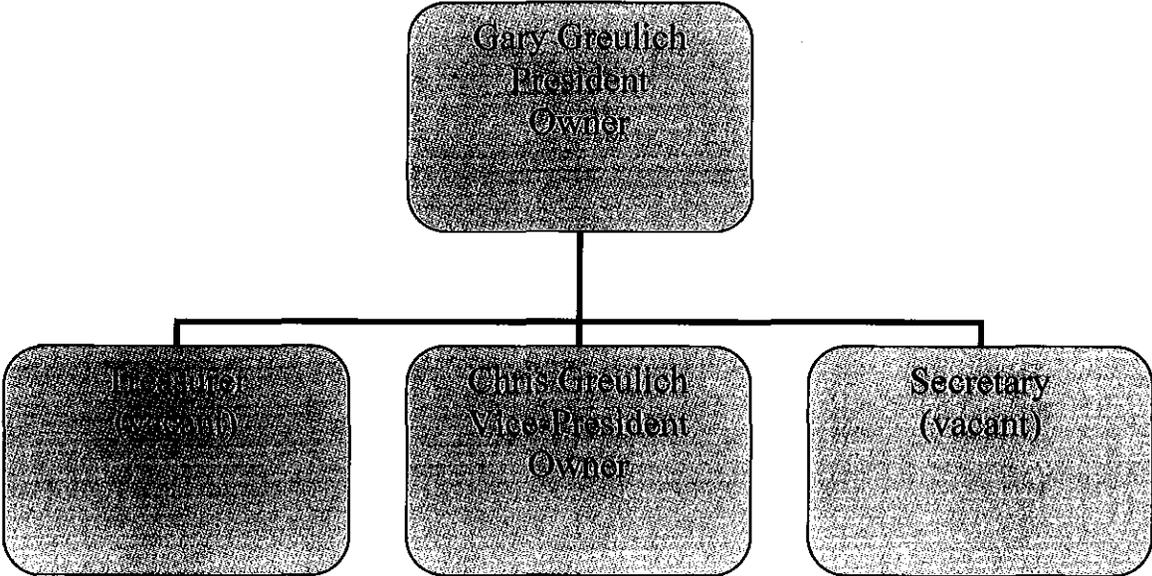
The bond filed in this docket is in favor of B'Mark Energy, Inc., rather than the Applicant, and there is no explanation in the Application of the relationship between B'Mark Energy and the Applicant. The Applicant is directed to submit an original license or permit bond in the Applicant's name in this proceeding pursuant to Section 454.80. ✓

Section 454.60 Managerial Licensing Requirements:

Subsection 454.60(c) of the Code states, "The applicant shall include in its application an exhibit containing a corporate organizational chart and indicating the positions of persons indicated in subsection (a) of this Section."

Applicant stated, "Exhibit 2 includes an exhibit containing a corporate organizational chart and identifying the persons who are being used to meet the requirements of Part 454.60(a)", however the required organizational chart was not in the application. Applicant is directed to provide the required organizational chart pursuant to Subsection 454.60(c) of the Code. ✓

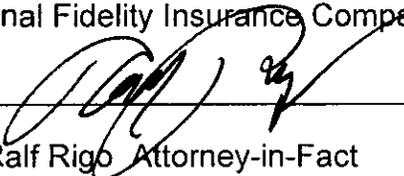
