COMPLAINT FOR PRELIMINARY AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION

NOW COMES Plaintiff, County of LaSalle and the LaSalle County  
Emergency Telephone Systems Board, by the LaSalle County State's Attorneys  
Office, its attorney and complaining of Defendants, C-R Telephone Company,  
d/b/a Fairpoint Communications, AT&T Corp., Gallatin River Communications,  
L.L.C., Leonore Mutual Telephone Company, Inc., The Marseilles Telephone  
Company of Marseilles, Illinois, McNabb Telephone Company, Tonica Telephone  
Company, Lightyear Network solutions, L.L.C., Bell Atlantic Communications,  
Inc. d/b/a Verizon Long Distance states as follows:

1. That the County of LaSalle is a county existing under the laws of  
the State of Illinois.

2. That the LaSalle County Emergency Telephone Systems Board is the duly appointed Board by the County of LaSalle under the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/15.4 to plan and implement a 9-1-1 emergency telephone system countywide.

3. Defendants are telecommunications carriers operating exchanges and lines within the County of LaSalle.

4. To meet the goals of the Emergency Telephone System Act and pursuant to 50 ILCS 750/15.4(d), Plaintiffs have requested that Defendants provide published numbers, non-published numbers, non-listed numbers, and their associated addresses and names ("subscriber records") so that Plaintiffs can upgrade their 9-1-1 emergency telephone system. The upgraded system (called "enhanced 9-1-1" or a "sophisticated 9-1-1 system") will among other things, display the name, address, and telephone number of the person calling 9-1-1.

5. Upon information and belief, the Defendants are willing to disclose their subscriber records, but may not do so until the entry of a proper order as mandated by Section 725.400(e) of the Illinois Administrative Code. Section 725.400(c) provides that "prior to any initial database integrity verification, system management shall obtain a court order detailing the information that is to be disclosed and the reason for disclosure."

6. Defendants' subscriber records are relevant and necessary to Plaintiffs providing accurate and timely emergency assistance and for Plaintiffs to operate its enhanced 9-1-1 system efficiently and effectively.

7. Disclosure of Defendants' subscriber records to Plaintiffs for the sole purpose of assisting it and responding to such emergency calls will serve a legitimate public safety purpose.

8. Immediate and irreparable injury will result to Plaintiffs and the residents it serves unless a permanent injunction is issued because, in the absence of such injunction, Defendants may not provide subscriber records, and the lack of these records will substantially impede Plaintiffs' ability to provide emergency services, thereby increasing the risk of injury or death to such residents and increasing the risk of damage to their property.

9. Disclosure of Defendants' subscriber records to Plaintiffs for the sole purpose of assisting it in responding to emergency law enforcement, fire and medical calls will only be under such terms and conditions as will protect the privacy of subscribers, insure that such acts does not disrupt Defendants' telephone service or place an unreasonable burden on Defendants' subscribers or services.


10. Plaintiffs have no adequate remedy at law.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiffs' pray that this Honorable Court grant the following equitable relief:

(a) That a preliminary and permanent injunction enter instanter, pursuant to Section 725.400(e) of the Illinois Administrative Code, ordering Defendants to provide subscriber records relating to Plaintiffs' area of responsibility to Plaintiffs

(b) That Plaintiffs bond be waived

(c) For such other and further relief that this Court may deem equitable and just.
