1. Review the modified plan based on the information provided in the application and allow the parties to waive a hearing on this matter.
2. Enter an order approving the modifications of the existing plan submitted herewith and authorizing the implementation of said modification of the Marshall County Emergency Telephone System described herein.





NARATIVE

The narrative statement in the Marshall County ETSB's original petition stands the same, noting the desired exception outlined in the following Opt-In/Opt-Out agreements.

The Marshall County ETSB desires to modify their E 9-1-1 system by opt-in of approximately ten (10) Frontier Communications customers residing in LaSalle County, in the Minonk exchange (815)-432. The specific customers are noted in the specific Opt-In agreement dated 17 October 2010, and included as exhibit herein.

The Marshall County ETSB also, desires to modify their E 9-1-1 system by opt-out to LaSalle County of approximately three (3) Frontier Communications customers residing in Marshall County, in the Lostant exchange (815)-368. The specific customers are noted in the specific Opt-In agreement dated 17 October 2010, and included as exhibit herein.

An intergovernmental agreement has been agreed to and signed by both the Marshall County ETSB Coordinator and the LaSalle County ETSB Chairman.

If said residents requests emergency services through 9-1-1, for the convenience of the two systems, it is desirable that LaSalle County PSAP take the request and then contact Marshall County Sheriff's PSAP for dispatching the request. Either of the two methods listed below may be used:

Call Handling

The LaSalle County PSAP receiving the call for emergency services in Marshall County shall relay the call in the following manner:

For Fire or Ambulance emergencies:

LaSalle County will direct dispatch the incident, using methods described in the call handling agreement with Lostant Fire or Lostant Ambulance.

For Police emergencies:

Primary: Direct 911 transfer to Marshall County dispatch via selective router.

Secondary: Point to Point Radio (155.370 MHz) – LaSalle County Sheriff to Marshall County Sheriff

Tertiary: Call Relay via telephone (309-246-2115), or via LEADS messaging to Marshall County (Terminal ID "HXM")

AID OUTSIDE JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARY

Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a request through the 9-1-1 system, such unit shall render its service to the requesting party without regard to whether the unit is operating outside of its normal jurisdictional boundaries.

The legislative intent is that 9-1-1 be used for emergency calls only. Therefore, all calls of an administrative or non-emergency nature shall be referred to your agency's published telephone number.

The PSAP Center agrees to keep all records, times, and places of all calls. All records will be available to all participants of the 9-1-1 System.

It shall be the responsibility of your agency to maintain the report of the call and the disposition of each call received.

All agreements, management, records, and service will be the responsibility of the advisory and policy board.


