NARRATIVE

The narrative statement in the Putnam County ETSB's original petition stands the same, noting the desired exception outlined in the following Opt-In/Opt-Out agreements.

The Putnam County ETSB desires to modify their E 9-1-1 system by opt-in of approximately two (2) Frontier Communications customers residing in LaSalle County, in the Granville exchange (815)-339 AND one (1) Frontier Communications customer residing in LaSalle county, in the magnolia exchange (815)-869. The specific customers are noted in the specific Opt-In agreements dated 17 June 2010, and included as exhibit herein.

The Putnam County ETSB also, desires to modify their E 9-1-1 system by opt-out to LaSalle County of approximately one (1) Frontier Communications customer residing in Putnam County, in the Cedar Point exchange (815)-446. The specific customers are noted in the specific Opt-In agreement dated 17 June 2010, and included as exhibit herein.






