REQUEST NO. REACT 6.07:

Please provide a copy of any and all instructions, guidelines or other documents used by ComEd to determine what assets are included in its provision of "standard service" (a) to the Extra Large Load class; and (b) to any other customer class.

RESPONSE:

In this data request, ComEd understands the use of the "assets" to mean the distribution facilities that must be installed on or near a customer's premises to provide electric service.

ComEd's Schedule of Rates on file with the Illinois Commerce Commission as ILL. C. C. No. 10 provides the guidelines for providing standard service. The specific assets that ComEd selects to provide standard service depend upon the customer's load and voltage requirements, the customer's location in relation to ComEd's existing distribution facilities, the available capacity on those existing ComEd distribution facilities, and any operational requirements or restrictions necessary for the operation of ComEd's distribution system.
