MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE CORRECTED BRIEF ON EXCEPTIONS

NOW Come the People of the State of Illinois, by Lisa Madigan, Attorney General of the State of Illinois (“the People”), and the Citizens Utility Board (“CUB”), and pursuant to Part 200.190 of the Illinois Commerce Commission’s rules, 83 ILL. Admin. Code Part 200.190, hereby request leave to file a Corrected Brief on Exceptions in the above entitled docket. In support of their Motion, the People and CUB state as follows:

1. On April 12, 2011, the People and CUB filed their joint Brief on Exceptions in response to the Proposed Order issued on March 18, 2011, by the Administrative Law Judge in this proceeding.
2. In reviewing their Brief on Exceptions, the People and CUB determined that there were errors in the Brief on Exceptions that require correction. Because some of these errors go beyond mere typographical mistakes, the People and CUB determined filing a corrected brief was appropriate rather than an errata.
3. Therefore, in order to correct these errors, the People and CUB seek leave to file a Corrected Brief on Exceptions.

4. The Corrected Brief on Exceptions accompanying this Motion makes certain changes, 1) in Section II. A correcting a punctuation error; 2) in Section II. B deleting sentences and correcting the numbers in a citation; 3) in Section II. B replacing the Analysis & Conclusions section, with the new Analysis & Conclusions in bold in the redline version; and, 4) adding page numbers to all sections of the pleading.

WHEREFORE, the People and CUB request that they be granted leave to file the attached "Corrected Brief on Exceptions" in substitution for the Brief on Exceptions filed by the People and CUB on April 12, 2011.


