1 PROCEEDINGS

2 JUDGE TAPIA: By the authority vested in me by
3 the Illinois Commerce Commission, I now call Docket
4 No. 11-0347. This case is entitled Illinois Bell
5 Telephone Company and XO Communications Services,
6 Inc. This is a joint petition for approval of a 23rd
7 amendment to the Interconnection Agreement. This is
8 dated April 11, 2011. This is pursuant to 47 U.S.C.
9 Section 252.

10 May I have appearances for the record,
11 please?

12 MR. HUTTENHOWER: James Huttenhower appearing
13 on behalf of Illinois Bell Telephone, 225 West
14 Randolph Street, Suite 25D, Chicago, Illinois 60606.

15 MR. ROLAND: And on behalf of XO Communications
16 Services Inc., Thomas Roland with the law firm of
17 Roland & Moore, 200 West Superior Street, Suite 400,
18 Chicago, Illinois 60654.

19 MR. WEGING: And this is James Weging, 160
20 North LaSalle Street, Suite C-800, Chicago, Illinois
21 60601, (312)793-2877 appearing on behalf of
22 Commission staff.

1 JUDGE TAPIA: Thank you.

2 I will let the record reflect that
3 there are no others wishing to enter an appearance.

4 Mr. Huttenhower and Mr. Roland, have
5 you received and reviewed staff Mr. Omoniyi's
6 verified statement in this case?

7 MR. HUTTENHOWER: Illinois Bell has received
8 it, Your Honor.

9 MR. ROLAND: Yes, Your Honor, XO has received
10 it.

11 JUDGE TAPIA: Thank you.

12 Mr. Weging, if you could please
13 describe the verified statement for the record?

14 MR. WEGING: Yes.

15 Staff has filed and served the
16 verified statement of A. Olusanjo Omoniyi.
17 Mr. Omoniyi recommends approval of this amendment
18 finding nothing discriminatory and nothing against
19 the public interest. It's subject to the usual
20 post-approval requirements that Illinois Bell amend
21 its tariffs to indicate the existence of this
22 amendment and that Illinois Bell file a verified

1 statement with our clerk's office so that this
2 amendment can be put on the Commission website.

3 In view of all that, I will identify
4 the verified statement of A. Olusanjo Omoniyi as
5 found on Commission e-Docket as Staff Exhibit 1 and
6 move that it be admitted into record evidence.

7 I note for the record it was filed on
8 April 15th at 1:09 p.m. and bears tracking number
9 125204.

10 JUDGE TAPIA: Thank you, Mr. Weging.

11 Mr. Huttenhower, do you have any
12 objection to the admission of Staff Exhibit 1 in this
13 docket?

14 MR. HUTTENHOWER: No objection, Your Honor.

15 JUDGE TAPIA: Mr. Roland, do you have any
16 objection to the admission of Staff Exhibit 1 in this
17 docket?

18 MR. ROLAND: No, Your Honor, XO has no
19 objection.

20 JUDGE TAPIA: Thank you.

21 There being no objection to the
22 admission of Mr. Omoniyi's verified statement, Staff

1 Exhibit 1 is admitted into evidence.

2 (Whereupon Staff Exhibit 1 was
3 admitted into evidence at this
4 time.)

5 JUDGE TAPIA: Mr. Huttenhower, do you agree to
6 implement the recommendations that staff has
7 recommended in this case?
