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Section 431.330 Technical Qualifications

NextEra meets the Technical Qualifications under 451.330 as demonstrated below:

NextEra operates a supply and scheduling group to manage NextEra's retail load in the State of Illinois. Located in Houston, Texas, this group is responsible for providing the components of full-requirements power for NextEra's Illinois load. This group consists of experienced buyers and sellers of power and energy, schedulers and support personnel such as accountants, credit analysts, and a legal group. The dedicated telephone numbers to reach the members of this group are (713) 401-5708/401-5676 and the dedicated facsimile number to reach them is (713) 401-5873. The address for the scheduling facility of NextEra is 20455 State Highway 249, Suite 200, Houston, Texas 77070.

Members of NextEra's supply and scheduling group are responsible for the execution, purchases, and hedging of power, transmission and other necessary components of retail service for all of NextEra's Illinois customers. Members of this group have extensive trading, scheduling, and operations experience with OASIS reservations and the NERC tagging process. The experience of NextEra in this field exceeds the minimum required by the Illinois Commerce Commission.

Mr. Hay has more than four years of experience buying and selling power and energy in wholesale markets and more than one year of scheduling experience for NextEra, an affiliate of NextEra Energy Power Marketing, Inc., a member of MISO and PJM, and Reliant Energy, Inc.'s subsidiary, Reliant Energy Northeast, LLC, a PJM member. Mr. Hay joined NextEra in August 2010. On behalf of NextEra, Mr. Hay is responsible for managing the pricing and structuring process for all wholesale and retail power and energy transactions.
