JUDGE JONES: Good morning. I call for hearing Docket Number 10-0481. This is titled, in part, Illinois-American Water Company, petition for approval of an agreement with American Lake Water Company, an affiliated interest, in accordance with Section 7-101 of the Public Utilities Act.

At this time we will take the respective appearances orally for the record. If you have not entered an appearance at a prior hearing, please spell your -- well, you need not spell your name. We have that on e-Docket, but give us your business address and business phone number. We will start with the appearances on behalf of Illinois-American Water Company.
