



NARRATIVE STATEMENT**

The Southwest Central 9-1-1 System, 7611 W. College Drive, Palos Heights, Illinois provides 9-1-1 Service for the Village of Chicago Ridge, the Village of Dixmoor, the Village of Lemont, the City of Palos Heights, the City of Palos Hills, the Village of Palos Park, the Village of Worth, the Lemont Fire Protection District, the Palos Fire Protection District, the Palos Heights Fire Protection District and the North Palos Fire Protection District. A contractual agreement between Southwest Central Dispatch and the DuPage County 9-1-1 System provides for the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System to provide Enhanced 9-1-1 Service for the Village of Clarendon Hills and the Village of Willowbrook.

Southwest Central Dispatch will no longer be providing service to the Village of Dixmoor. 9-1-1 Calls that are received for the Village of Dixmoor will be direct transferred to the Blue Island PSAP or will be dispatched to the Blue Island PSAP via radio (155.070).

Call handling agreements with the Dixmoor Police and Fire Department and the Blue Island PSAP were secured. Agreements with the Alsip Police Department, the Darien Police Department and the Orland Park Police Department for alternate PSAP backup are already in place and on file with the Commission. Adjacent agency agreements are already in place and on file with the Commission.

Southwest Central Dispatch currently utilizes a shared net communications system for participating agencies. Compatibility with adjacent agencies is facilitated by a shared net communication system, a point-to-point radio communication system, a mutual aid frequency or by direct dialing or transferring calls.

Ameritech is the sole telephone company servicing the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System. Eight(8) exchanges servicing one hundred SIXTY-FIVE(165) prefixes presently serve the System and are detailed in Exhibit 5.

**ADDENDUM TO SOUTHWEST CENTRAL 9-1-1 SYSTEM
NARRATIVE STATEMENT**

March 12, 2001

The Southwest Central 9-1-1 System, 7611 W. College Drive, Palos Heights, Illinois provides 9-1-1 Service for the Village of Chicago Ridge, the Village of Dixmoor, the Village of Lemont, the City of Palos Heights, the City of Palos Hills, the Village of Palos Park, the Village of Worth, the Lemont Fire Protection District, the Palos Fire Protection District, the Palos Heights Fire Protection District and the North Palos Fire Protection District.

A contractual agreement between Southwest Central Dispatch and the DuPage County 9-1-1 System provides for the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System to provide Enhanced 9-1-1 Service for the Village of Clarendon Hills and the Village of Willowbrook. A contractual agreement between Southwest Central Dispatch and the Burr Ridge ETSB and provides for the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System to provide Enhanced 9-1-1 Service for the Village Burr Ridge beginning April 30, 2001.

Agreements with the Alsip Police Department, the Darien Police Department and the Orland Park Police Department for alternate PSAP backup are already in place and on file with the Commission. Adjacent agency agreements are already in place and on file with the Commission for both Southwest Central 911 System and the Burr Ridge ETSB.

Southwest Central Dispatch currently utilizes a shared net communications system for participating agencies. Compatibility with adjacent agencies is facilitated by a shared net communication system, a point-to-point radio communication system, a mutual aid frequency or by direct dialing or transferring calls. 9-1-1 Calls will be dispatched to the Burr Ridge Police Department via direct dispatch by radio (476.7375 MHz) and/or via direct dispatch with mobile data terminals (858.2625 MHz). The police and fire agencies adjacent to Burr Ridge will receive 9-1-1 calls by direct call transfer to their PSAPs, Point to Point Radio - 155.370 MHz, Fire Main - 154.250 MHz or NIFERN - 154.265 MHz.

Ameritech is the sole telephone company servicing the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System. Eight(8) exchanges servicing one hundred SIXTY-FIVE(165) prefixes presently serve the System and are detailed in Exhibit 5.



For 9-1-1 Emergency Communications

This agreement is made between the Southwest Central 9-1-1 System Public Safety Answering Point Center, hereinafter referred to as "PSAP", and the Dixmoor Fire Department, for the purpose of effective handling and routing of 9-1-1 Emergency calls.

CALL HANDLING

Southwest Central 9-1-1 System PSAP receiving a call for emergency services in your jurisdiction shall dispatch the call in the following manner:

Primary: Direct Transfer to Blue Island 9-1-1 PSAP

Secondary: Blue Island 9-1-1 PSAP: Point to Point Radio 155.370

AID OUTSIDE JURISDICTION BOUNDARY

Once an emergency unit is dispatched in response to a request through the system, such unit shall render its service to the requesting party without regard to whether the unit is operating outside its normal jurisdictional boundaries.

The legislative intent is that 9-1-1 be used for emergency calls only. Therefore, all call of an administrative or non-emergency nature shall be referred to the Village of Dixmoor's published telephone number.

The Blue Island ETSB/PSAP agrees to keep all records, times, and places of all calls. All records will be available to all participants of the 9-1-1 System.




