

6. Defendant failed to respond to the scene over the next several days, despite at least three follow-up calls by Plaintiff to Defendant, during each of which Defendant's representative told Plaintiff that they "were on the way" and would promptly respond.

7. At all times Plaintiff acted in a prudent and reasonable manner to minimize the damage caused by the failure of Defendant's equipment.

8. It was the duty of Defendant to use due care to maintain its equipment, and to respond to Plaintiff's notification that said equipment had been damaged.

9. Defendant breached that duty of due care by failing to properly maintain its equipment and by failing to respond in a prompt and reasonable manner to Plaintiff's notification of damage to its equipment.

10. As a direct and proximate result of the negligence of the Plaintiff, said equipment further degraded causing the electrical service to Plaintiff's said residence to be totally interrupted, causing Plaintiff to incur damages for replacement of electrical equipment (\$1200.00); damage to landscaping (\$1377.56) and loss of refrigerated food (\$621.62)

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff RALPH TRASK, asks this Court to enter judgment in favor of Plaintiff and against Defendant, COMMONWEALTH EDISION COMPANY, for the sum of \$3,199.18, plus court costs.
