If Ms. Grace's answers to any of these subparts are anything other than an unqualified no, please fully explain in detail how Ms. Grace took these facts into consideration. Please provide all documents, analyses, calculations, and workpapers reviewed or prepared in preparing the Companies' answer.

Although S.C. Nos. 1 and 2 customers may elect service under Rider CFY, Choices For YouSM, Ms. Grace has no opinion on whether those customers benefit from having the option. Ms. Grace did not take above items a) and b) into consideration as the Rider AGG administration charges are assessed to suppliers based on costs caused by suppliers who desire to provide gas supply service to customers.
