**ComEd Corporate History**


In 1887, Chicago Edison Company incorporated with capitalization of \$500,000 to develop an incandescent-light business in Chicago. Led by then President Samuel Insull, Edison began service with a maximum load of 313 kilowatts, generated from the company's three-story building on West Adams near downtown.

On September 17, 1907, Chicago Edison Co. and Commonwealth Electric Light and Power Co. formally merged to create Commonwealth Edison Co., Inc. ("ComEd"). Over the next thirty years ComEd experienced rapid growth with the installation of its millionth meter in the new Chicago Daily News Building and the 1913 merger with south side utility, Cosmopolitan Electric.


In 1949, ComEd received a 42-year franchise as the exclusive supplier of electricity to Chicago. The following year, the company announced the study of nuclear power, culminating in 1960 with construction of the world's first full-scale, privately financed nuclear power plant, Dresden Station.

In 1994, ComEd became part of newly formed parent company Unicom; Unicom then announced a merger with Philadelphia-based PECO Energy Co. in 1999. Upon completion of the merger the new parent company took the name Exelon Corporation.

Currently, ComEd operates as a unit of Chicago-based Exelon Corporation, one of the nation's largest utilities. ComEd and its more than 5,900 employees are responsible for maintaining approximately 65,000 miles of power lines which deliver electricity to approximately 3.8 million customers. Today ComEd is engaged principally in the purchase, transmission, distribution and sale of electricity to a diverse base of residential, commercial, industrial and wholesale customers in northern Illinois. All of ComEd's energy generation assets were either sold to third parties (i.e., Midwest Generation) or transferred to Exelon subsidiary, Exelon Generation Co. between 1996 and 2001.




**Orders affecting ComEd entered by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) since ComEd filed its last rate case on June 30, 2010 (Illinois Commerce Commission Docket No. 10-0467)**

- **Filings made by ComEd or on behalf of ComEd**

ER11-3577 - On 5/16/11, FERC accepted for filing ministerial revisions to the PJM Tariff.

ER09-1145 – On 3/12/10, FERC issued a letter accepting ComEd’s 5/15/09 filing, Formula Rate Annual Update. Other parties were allowed 180 days to challenge the filing and none did. All subsequent annual updates are filed under this docket number. ComEd filed annual updates on 5/15/10 and 5/16/11.

ER10-2545-000 - On 11/2/10, FERC accepted for filing ComEd’s proposed tariff provisions which provided a description of the methodology used to determine Capacity Peak Load Contributions and Network Service Peak Load

Contributions. On 11/30/10, ComEd submitted a filing to comply with the Commission’s 11/2/10 Order. That filing was accepted by FERC on 12/30/10.

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QM10-6-000 - On 4/6/11, FERC issued an Order granting ComEd's application to terminate mandatory purchase obligations with Qualifying Facilities with net capacity greater than 20 MW. On 9/13/10, ComEd filed an application proposing to terminate the obligation to enter into new power purchase obligations or contracts to purchase energy and capacity from qualifying cogeneration and small power production facilities with net capacity in excess of 20 MW.

- **Filings made by others that affect ComEd retail charges**

ER11-2622-000 - On 3/31/11, FERC issued an Order accepting PJM's revised tariff sheets for the PJM Regional Transmission Expansion Plan (RTEP) transmission facilities that operate at or above 500 kV, and suspending them for a nominal period, to become effective April 4, 2011, subject to refund and subject to the outcome of further proceedings. Further, the Commission accepted other revised tariff sheets for the costs of RTEP transmission facilities that operate below 500 kV to become effective April 4, 2011. PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. amendments to Schedule 12-Appendix of the PJM tariff incorporated cost responsibility assignments for 234 baseline upgrades included in the update to the RTEP approved by the PJM Board Managers ("PJM Board") on December 1, 2010.

ER11-2578-000 - On 2/1/11, FERC issued an order accepting PJM revisions to Schedule 12-Appendix of the PJM tariff. PJM amended Schedule 12-Appendix of the PJM tariff to revise the cost responsibility assignments for existing Regional Facilities and Necessary Lower Voltage Facilities to reflect updated cost responsibility. The proposed revisions update the annual cost

allocations for Regional Facilities and Necessary Lower Voltage Facilities included in RTEP to reflect changes in peak loads for the 12 months ending October 31, 2010.

RM10-17-000 - On 3/15/11 FERC issued a Final Rule on Demand Response Compensation in Organized Wholesale Energy Markets (Order No. 745). Order No. 745 amends the Commission's regulations, adding section 35.28(g)(1)(v), to provide that each Commission approved independent system operator (ISO) or regional transmission organization (RTO) that permits demand response resources to participate as a resource in the energy market must: (1) pay to those demand response resources the market price for energy for reductions when these resources have the capability to balance supply and demand and when payment of the market price for energy to these resources is cost-effective as determined by a net benefits test accepted by the Commission; and (2) allocate the costs associated with the demand response compensation proportionally to all entities that purchase from the relevant energy market in the area(s) where the demand response reduces the market price for energy at the time when the demand response resource is committed or dispatched. Accordingly, in this Final Rule, the Commission directed all RTOs and ISOs to make a compliance filing by July 22, 2011, to include tariff changes needed to implement the compensation approach required in the Final Rule, including the net benefits test provisions, measurement and verification proposed changes (or explanation), and cost allocation mechanism provisions. Additionally, all RTOs and ISOs must file by September 21, 2012, the results of a study examining the requirements for and impacts of determining when paying demand response resources the Locational Marginal Price results in net benefits to customers in both the day-ahead and real-time energy markets.

ER11-3106-000 - On 5/4/11, FERC issued an Order accepting PJM amendments to Schedule 12-Appendix of the PJM tariff. PJM Interconnection, LLC submitted amendments to Schedule 12 Appendix of the PJM tariff to include cost responsibility assignments for 12 baseline upgrades included in the update to the RTEP approved by the PJM Board on February 14, 2011 and one upgrade (b1255) approved by the PJM Board on December 1, 2010.

RM 10-23-000 - On 7/21/11. FERC issued Order 1000 which amends transmission planning and cost allocation requirements established in Order 890. ICC filed a request for rehearing on 8/19/11 under RM10-23.

ER-06-043 - On 9/30/11, the Commission issued an Order on Rehearing which denied rehearing of several previous Orders dealing with the Seams Elimination/Cost Adjustment/Assignment (SECA) transition mechanism. The Order denied rehearing of previous orders dealing with the elimination of regional through-and-out rates in the PJM Interconnection, LLC and Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator (MISO) regions.

ER11-4367 - On 10/20/11, the Commission issued an Order conditionally accepting in part revisions to the PJM Tariff to update Schedule 12-Appendix.

PJM indicated the revisions were previously accepted by the Commission; but, were not currently reflected in the PJM Tariff.
