Dear Mr. O'Neill:

Commission Staff has completed a preliminary review of the petition for a general rate increase that was filed by Commonwealth Edison Company ("ComEd") on November 8, 2011. Pursuant to 83 Ill. Adm. Code 285.145, ComEd is directed to provide a response that is verified by someone with personal knowledge of the facts which includes the missing information and clarifications described below.

The verified response shall be filed with the Office of the Chief Clerk of the Commission within 28 days from receipt of this letter. Two copies shall also be served on us, (one for each Administrative Law Judge) in the Chicago office, and one each to all of the Commission Staff/General Counsel's Office personnel that are listed on the service list in Docket 10-0467.

83 Ill. Adm. Code 285.310(f)(2): General Information Requirements

Subsection 285.310(f)(2) requires each filing utility to provide a historical analysis of a utility's typical daily load shape, by season, for the previous five years. ComEd provided information reflecting that daily load shape by season; however, it did not

provide analysis of that information. ComEd must provide the required analysis in order to comply with Subsection 285.310(f)(2).
