**RESPONDENT'S BRIEF ON EXCEPTIONS**

Now come the Respondent, Commonwealth Edison Company ("Respondent" or "ComEd") by and through its attorney, Mark L. Goldstein, and files Respondent's Brief on Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Proposed Order ("ALJPO") in the captioned matter dated December 16, 2011 pursuant to 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.830.

ComEd only takes exception to Finding (6) on page 6 of the ALJPO and requests that Finding (6) be stricken and deleted. Finding (6) states, as follows:


(6) Commonwealth Edison is directed to review its bill format to provide some notification to customers of bill impacts due to events like rescinded service deposits or lapsed deferred payment arrangements.

ComEd maintains that Finding (6), which directs a global change in the billing format for all ComEd customers is not an appropriate finding in this individual complaint proceeding. ComEd further maintains that there is not a sufficient evidentiary record to make such a finding. Indeed, there is no record evidence regarding the costs to change ComEd's bill format versus any supposed customer benefit.

As noted in the Commission Analysis and Conclusions section, page 5, these billing questions may be addressed in the Commission's rulemaking. The Commission's rulemaking docket has been ongoing for the past four years with full and complete

For all of the reasons set forth above, Commonwealth Edison Company respectfully requests the Administrative Law Judge and the Illinois Commerce Commission to strike and delete Finding (6) of the Administrative Law Judge's Proposed Order of December 16, 2011.
