

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- 1) In April of 2007 Ameren cut trees and let them lay on the ground. They had no easement to do so. They came back later and cleaned them up.

- 2) On July 16th 2007, I found that someone had installed a temporary meter poll on my property. It was about 60 feet from the property line. Over the next three weeks I called Tom Kepple several times and told him I did not want it connected. On August 3rd 2007, I found that the pole was connected with electricity. In the morning of August 6th 2007, Mike Welch came to my property to talk about the pole. I would not give Ameren an easement for that portion of my property. He later concluded that Ameren did not have an easement. The temporary pole was disconnected that afternoon.

- 3) On or about November 30th 2007 Ameren removed about 1100 feet of overhead line , Poles and a transformer from the portion of my property from which they did not have an easement. These lines were removed without my permission or notification. They moved these items to property and easement owned by my neighbor (Douglas Shaub). They did not charge him for the full amount of the service. Ameren wants to charge me to replace the lines back to the point which it was removed.
