

1. On March 5th, 2010 my father Gilbert C. Hernandez was found deceased by me. (Anthony J Hernandez) At that point I couldn't bear with living there and moved in with my girlfriend and family at 69th street in Darien, IL. During the course of me living with my father I had not known the electric was under my name ever.
2. After I left the residence the electric was left on by sheriffs and doctors that surveillanced the residence to secure the scene. Few months later I received a call that it was disconnected but thought nothing of it considering I was still dealing with the constant struggle of losing my father.
3. Months later received collection letters from Harris and Harris in Chicago. I fought it with them never heard back and then a few months down the road received another from ICS based in Minnesota. I fought this again with them and copied in the letter my attorney Bruce Bozich who is aware of this issue.
4. After moving on and getting my head above water I obtained my condo and was shocked that this was still associated with my name and have been fighting it for months now and spent countless hours on the phone or faxing docs to remove this from my records. My attempts came with no avail.
5. I then obtained a letter from the second collection agency explaining this was removed from them and no further action will be used but in this case has no merit.
6. My next talk was with Beth at ICC and she informed me to ask for a formal hearing.
7. My complaint is being filed because I stopped living at the residence in the beginning of March and there was service rendered for months without being and unbeknownst to me was under my name.
