2 JUDGE JONES: Thank you. Commission Staff?

3 MR. KNEPLER: My name is Steven R. Knepler,
4 K-N-E-P-L-E-R. I am appearing on behalf of the Staff
5 of the Illinois Commerce Commission. My business

9 JUDGE JONES: Thank you. Are there any other
10 appearances?

11 (No response.)

12 Let the record show there are not.

13 Putting the notice question aside for
14 the moment, it is my understanding that everyone is
15 ready to proceed with identification and offering of
16 their testimony into the evidentiary record with
17 affidavits to be provided at a later date.

18 Is Ameren Illinois Company ready to go
19 forward with the identification of those items?

20 MR. FITZHENRY: Yes, Your Honor. The Company
21 would introduce into evidence the direct testimony of
22 Steven, S-T-E-V-E-N, E. Martin as Ameren Exhibit 1.0,

1 including his exhibit Ameren Exhibits 1.1 and 1.2.
2 We would submit that Mr. Martin's affidavit would be
3 identified for the record as Ameren Exhibit 1.3.

4 We would also move for the admission
5 into the record the direct testimony of Danielle,
6 D-A-N-I-E-L-L-E, R. Moskop, M-O-S-K-O-P. Ms.
7 Moskop's direct testimony is identified as Ameren
8 Exhibit 2.0. And Ms. Moskop also has an exhibit
9 Ameren Exhibit 2.1. We suggest that her affidavit be
10 identified as Ameren Exhibit 2.2.

11 JUDGE JONES: All right. Thank you. Those are
12 being offered at this time, is that correct?

13 MR. FITZHENRY: They are.

14 JUDGE JONES: Any objection?

15 MR. KNEPLER: No objection.

16 JUDGE JONES: Let the record show those
17 exhibits being Ameren exhibits are hereby admitted
18 into the evidentiary record subject to the filing of
19 the affidavits to be identified as Ameren Exhibits
20 1.3 and 2.2 as indicated by Mr. Fitzhenry, and that
21 includes all the numbered exhibits that are
22 identified on e-Docket as having been filed on April

10 MR. KNEPLER: Staff is moving for the admission
11 of Staff Exhibit 1.0. This is testimony that was
12 previously filed on the Commission's e-Docket system
13 on December 14, 2011, and it has been identified as
14 the direct testimony of Richard W. Bridal, II.
15 Mr. Bridal's testimony consists of a cover page,
16 table of contents and four pages of narrative
17 testimony and related Schedules 1.1 and 1.2.
