NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING

Dear Sir/Madam:

Notice is given that the Administrative Law Judge has completed a review of One Energy LLC's ("Applicant") February 23, 2012 filing and hereby rules that the information described below shall be filed with the Chief Clerk of the Illinois Commerce Commission ("Commission") on or before March 1, 2012. The response to this ruling must include (1) the docket number, case caption, and an original signature, (2) a verification page, and (3) a certificate of service indicating that the response was served on all those on the service list. The response to this ruling must be actually received by the Chief Clerk by the date indicated, regardless of whether the response is filed with the Chief Clerk electronically or as hardcopy. Applicant shall also electronically serve a Word version of its response on the Administrative Law Judge (jalbers@icc.illinois.gov) by the date indicated.

Technical Requirements

Section 454.70(a) and (b) requires Applicant to demonstrate it has experience in the electric industry of at least one year and to provide occupational background information for the person(s) with that experience. Despite having provided information in its application and in its responses to the February 2, 2012 and February 14, 2012 Administrative Law Judge rulings, exactly what experience Applicant has in the electric industry remains unclear. To remedy this situation, please provide the following information:

- 1) Identify one or more individuals employed by Applicant that Applicant is relying on to satisfy Section 454.70.
- 2) For each such individual, specify each company/business in the electric industry which employed the individual and identify the duration of employment by "month/year" to "month/year."

3) For each individual at each company/business in the electric industry, identify the individual's specific job duties. If the job duties are not specific to the electric industry, explain why the experience gained in the position should be considered experience in the electric industry.
