**Section 451.330(a).**

Public Power, LLC will not use electric generation, transmission, or distribution facilities that it owns, controls, or operates in serving customers, and therefore, the requirements of Section 451.330(a) are not applicable.

**Section 451.330(b) and Section 451.330(d)**

Public Power, LLC possesses the technical capabilities to serve retail customers identified in Section 451.330(b), as demonstrated below.
