

## Glossary of Terms

1994 Rate Case means the rate case proceeding undertaken in Docket No. 94-0065

2008 Rate Design Investigation means the proceeding undertaken in Docket No. 08-0532

Act means Public Utilities Act

ComEd means Commonwealth Edison Company

Commission means Illinois Commerce Commission, or ICC

EEI means Edison Electric Institute

IPA Act means Illinois Power Agency Act

kW means kilowatt, which is a measure of the rate at which electricity is delivered

kWh means kilowatt-hour, which is a measurement of the amount of electricity usage

MF means multi-family

MFSH means multi-family with electric space heat

Nonsummer monthly billing periods mean, generally, the January, February, March, April, May, October, November, and December monthly billing periods

Percentile means the number of customers in a delivery class that comprise 1/100th of the total number of customers in the delivery class, with delineations based upon annual electricity usage

Rate 14 means Rate 14 - Residential Service-Space Heating Customers

Rate BES means Rate BES - Basic Electric Service

Rate GAP means Rate GAP - Government Aggregation Protocols

RES means Retail Electric Supplier

Rider CPP means Rider CPP - Competitive Procurement Process

Rider PE means Rider PE - Purchased Electricity

SF means single family

## Glossary of Terms

SHSH means single family with electric space heat

Summer monthly billing periods mean, generally, the June, July, August, and September monthly billing periods.

Total annual bill means total annual charges billed for bundled electric service under Rate BES that include (1) electricity supply-related charges; (2) transmission service charges; (3) ICC-jurisdictional delivery service charges; and (4) various non-by-passable charges and adjustments, excluding state and municipal taxes

Volumetric charge means a charge that is applied on the basis of electricity usage
