Robert Palmese -- Managing Member and President

Robert Palmese is the Managing Member and President of Palmco Power II, LLC. He is in charge of the day-to-day operations of Palmco Power II and its affiliates. His responsibilities include oversight of all financial matters (including profit and loss), as well as overall company management of the purchase and scheduling of electricity and gas. Since 2002, he has had identical duties and responsibilities in connection with Palmco Power II's numerous affiliates that sell electric power and natural gas at retail in New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Maryland, Connecticut, Ohio, and Washington DC.
