

Dear Mr. McDaniel

As we discussed on the phone today, I am hereby authorizing ExxonMobile Pipeline Company to excavate the crude oil pipeline within your easement at its intersection with the highway right-of-way for Section 99-06001-00-FP. Also, as we discussed, one lane of the road will need to remain open at all times.

The ICC has budgeted money for this purpose in the amount of \$35,425.00. Moultrie County will reimburse ExxonMobile as detailed by the ICC Stipulated Agreement for an amount not to exceed \$35,425.00. Additionally, the work will be performed and completed no later than November 1, 2000. The County will reimburse ExxonMobile after all bills have been submitted in entirety and the County has received money from the State of Illinois.

It will be necessary that your project foreman contact me in advance of starting work so he can outline what he will be doing on the Right-of-Way, and in order to enable me to take the necessary steps to regulate traffic during the affected period. It is a further condition that ExxonMobile shall replace and compact the fill sufficient to support the road surface to IDOT standards: and this County shall replace the asphalt road surface to its present condition.


