Viridian Energy

Glacial Energy of Illinois, Inc. has recently discovered facts that could result in Glacial having been deemed an affiliate of Viridian Energy, Inc., Viridian Energy NY LLC and Viridian Energy PA LLC (collectively, the “Viridian Entities”).

Specifically, David Levy, who currently controls a greater than 10 percent interest in Glacial Energy Holdings, the upstream owner of Glacial Energy of Illinois, Inc., sat on the Board of Directors of Regional Energy Holdings (“Regional”) as well as the Board of Directors of Regional’s subsidiary, Viridian Energy, Inc. (“Viridian”) from August 18, 2010 to December 21, 2010 and May 2, 2011 to March 8, 2012. Regional is also the parent company of the Viridian Entities. Moreover, from August 18, 2010 to December 21, 2010, Isaac Barber held a 10 percent indirect interest in Glacial, while he held positions on the Regional Board and the Viridian Board. Finally, from December 21, 2010 to May 2, 2011, Mark Nordlicht indirectly owned 17.84 percent of Regional and arguably indirectly controlled 20 percent of Glacial. Mr. Levy and Mr. Barber subsequently resigned their positions on the Regional Board and Viridian Board, and Mr. Nordlicht no longer owns any interest in Regional.

Franklin Power

Gary Mole owns an 80% indirect interest in Glacial Energy of Illinois, Inc. through Glacial Energy Holdings. Mr. Mole was also the sole shareholder of Touchdown Properties,

LLC (“Touchdown”) which purchased a 60% interest in Franklin Power Company (“Franklin”) on November 25, 2003. Touchdown purchased the shares in Franklin solely as a passive investment.

As a result of Touchdown’s acquisition, Mr. Mole held an indirect, partial interest in Franklin. However, at no point did Mr. Mole have the ability to manage, nor did he manage the day-to-day business affairs of Franklin by virtue of his indirect interest.

The Public Utilities Commission of Texas (“PUCT”) revoked Franklin’s REP license on July 17, 2006, however, Franklin had ceased operations much earlier than the date on which the PUCT revoked its REP license, in or around May of 2005. It is our understanding that Touchdown, recognizing that Franklin was not a viable business venture, had effectively written off its investment in Franklin in or around mid-May of 2005.
