The following Special Provisions supplement the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", Adopted January 1, 2012, the latest edition of the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways", and the "Manual of Test Procedures of Materials" in effect on the date of invitation of bids, and the Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions indicated on the Check Sheet included here in which apply to and govern the construction of January 1, 2012, and in case of conflict with any part, or parts, of said Specifications, the said Special Provisions shall take precedence and shall govern.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The work included in this contract shall consist of construction of TR - 142 & TR - 158 with hot mix asphalt, aggregate base, aggregate shoulders and other work to complete the project.

TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

Traffic control shall be in accordance with the applicable sections of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, the applicable guidelines contained in the Illinois Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways, these Special Provisions, and any details and highway standards contained herein and in the plans.

Special attention is called to Articles 107.09, 701.04 and 701.05 of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and the following (1) Highway Standards, (2) Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions and (3) other Special Provisions relating to traffic control.

Highway Standards: 701901-02 and BLR 21-9 shall be used for the construction of TR - 142 and TR - 158. TR - 142 and TR - 158 will be closed to through traffic at all times during construction of this section. Any cost incurred by the contractor for this provision shall be included in the contract unit cost per one (1) lump sum TRAFFIC CONTROL AND PROTECTION and no other compensation shall be allowed.

TRENCH BACKFILL

The trench backfill for the 24" pipe extension will be coarse aggregate (CA - 6 or CA - 9) The work for trench backfill will be included in the cost of the CORUGATED METAL PIPE CULVERT TY 1 24".


OVERHAUL

No payment for overhaul will be allowed for earth moved to or from any source.

PRECAUTIONS FOR UTILITIES

The contractor will contact JULIE before the start of work

The contractor shall take whatever precautions which may be necessary to protect the property of the various public utilities which may be located underground or above ground, at or adjacent to the project location. The contractor will be required to, at their own expense, bear the cost to repair or replace any utility which has been damaged through negligence. The procedure and specifications of repair will be in accordance with the regulations and/or policy of the utility company.








Existing Cross Section



SPECIAL PROVISION
FOR
RAILROAD PROTECTIVE LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR LOCAL LETTINGS

Effective: March 1, 2005
Revised: January 1, 2006

All references to Sections or Articles in this specification shall be construed to mean a specific Section or Article of the Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, adopted by the Department of Transportation.

Railroad Protective Liability Insurance. The contractor will be required to carry Railroad Protective Liability and Property Damage Liability Insurance in accordance with Article 107.11 of the Standard Specifications. A separate policy is required for each railroad indicated on the attached form unless otherwise noted. The limits of liability for each policy are listed on the attached form. The minimum limits of liability shall be in accordance with Article 107.11 of the Standard Specifications.

Basis of Payment. The costs for providing insurance, as noted above, will be paid for at the contract unit price per Lump Sum for RAILROAD PROTECTIVE LIABILITY INSURANCE.

APPROVAL OF INSURANCE: The ORIGINAL and one CERTIFIED copy of each required policy shall be submitted for approval to the following address:

The contractor will be advised when approval of the insurance has been received from the railroad(s). Before any work begins on railroad right-of-way, the Contractor shall submit to the Resident Engineer evidence that the required railroad protective liability insurance has been approved by the railroad(s). The Contractor shall also provide the Resident Engineer with expiration date of each required policy.
