APPLICANT IEA'S RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE'S RULING

Dear Chief Clerk:

Notice was provided to us that Administrative Law Judge Albers has completed a review of the application filed by Illinois Energy Aggregation, LLC ("Applicant") on May 25, 2012 and hereby ruled that the information described below had to be filed with the Chief Clerk of the Illinois Commerce Commission on or before June 11, 2012. The response to this ruling was to include (1) the docket number, case caption, and an original signature, (2) a verification page, and (3) a certificate of service indicating that the response was served on all those on the service list. The response to this ruling must be actually received by the date indicated, regardless of whether the response is filed with the Chief Clerk electronically or as hardcopy. Applicant shall also electronically serve a Word version of its response on the Administrative Law Judge (jalbers@icc.illinois.gov) by the date indicated.

Please be advised that this is Illinois Energy Aggregation LLC's response to the June 4, 2012 notice:

Applicant indicated that it is relying on Mark Nakayama to satisfy the technical requirements necessary to become an agent, broker, or consultant ("ABC"). In the ruling provided to applicant, it stated that Mr. Nakayama's experience satisfies the technical requirements, however he was also recently used to satisfy the technical requirements for another ABC license applicant, JFN Consulting, Inc., in Docket No. 12-0340. The ruling asked for an explanation regarding Mr. Nakayama's relationship to applicant and the relationship of JFN Consulting Inc to applicant.

Mr. Nakayama is a consultant contractually retained by the applicant. As a contractual consultant and in accordance with the agreement between applicant and Mr. Nakayama, he is able to consult with other entities. Mr. Nakayama's contract term is for two years, but contains renewal clauses that could extend his service to the company.

JFN consulting Inc is not an affiliate of applicant and applicant is not an affiliate of JFN Consulting Inc. The principal of JFN Consulting Inc has a marital relationship with a principal of applicant. The applicant does intend to use JFN Consulting Inc as a consultant in the future but has not formalized any such agreement at this time.


