Michael D. Osowski, President

Mr. Osowski is responsible for the overall operations and performance of Oasis Energy. He has worked in the deregulated energy industry for fifteen years with two successful independent companies in retail power deregulation.

Since 1995, Mr. Osowski has worked with electric deregulation in California, Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Massachusetts, Texas, New York, and Maryland.

Prior to founding Oasis Energy, Mr. Osowski was Senior Vice President of Spark Energy L.P. From the early stages of the company, he was responsible for the growth, management, and overall operations for the electric side of the company. Mr. Osowski was highly involved in the management of Spark's outsourced sales vendors, in addition to the in-house sales team of over 100 directly employed sales agents.

In addition to his sales, managerial, and operational experience, Mr. Osowski brings years of supply experience to Oasis Energy. In 1997, Mr. Osowski joined the start-up Green Mountain Energy Company, where he led several supply projects for the company's effort to establish a presence in six deregulated states. His titles with Green Mountain included Director of Commercial and Industrial Power, and Director of Mid-Office Operations. Following BP Energy's investment in Green Mountain Energy in 1999, Mr. Osowski was seconded to BP Energy Trading, where he facilitated BP's entry into deregulated power markets. While in this role, he worked directly with the OASIS reservation process and the NERC tagging process.

Amy Van Gelder, Vice President

Mrs. Van Gelder has worked with electric deregulation for over ten years. She is responsible for all back office operations including systems, customer service, billing and transactions, regulatory compliance, and general management.

At the onset of electric deregulation of the Texas market in 2002, Mrs. Van Gelder joined a Houston-based retailer at the ground floor level and had a key role in establishing the company's operational framework.

Prior to joining Oasis Energy, Mrs. Van Gelder worked for Spark Energy from 2003 to 2009, where she managed several business units. Mrs. Van Gelder's titles while working with electric deregulation included Director of Business Development, New Markets Director, and Director of Operations. In her role as New Markets Director, Mrs. Van Gelder was responsible for managing all facets of the company's national expansion efforts.

Mrs. Van Gelder has over six years of supply experience in the Texas ERCOT, New York ISO, New England ISO and PJM markets. While in the New Markets role, she developed initial scheduling and forecasting models required to manage the company's load on a day-to-day basis, as well as the pricing models necessary to analyze customer load profiles for each respective new market. Mrs. Van Gelder was also active with the company's system software developers in their efforts to automate and standardize the supply and pricing tools she designed.

Prior to joining Oasis Energy he was employed by Spark Energy as Vice President Strategic Planning with responsibility of managing the company's accounting operations including forecasting, strategic planning, and budgeting. In addition to leading the company's process improvement initiatives, he was also chairman of the IT Steering Committee where he was instrumental in the company's software acquisition efforts.

Mr. Lupo has served in various roles of increasing responsibility in wholesale natural gas, utility operations and professional engineering firms for Superior Natural Gas Corporation, The Polaris Pipeline Corporation, Simmons J.
