
Dear Mr. Stoffels:

## NARRATIVE STATEMENT

The Lake County ETSB was granted authority to operate an E911 system in docket 93-0071.

The purpose of this petition is to request a modification of the original E911 application. The Lake County ETSB has agreed to opt out E911 wireline calls originating from the Village of Antioch as well as the Antioch Fire Protection District to the CenCom 911 Joint ETSB system (CenCom). CenCom will also be filing a modification in order to accept the E911 wireline calls originating from the Village of Antioch and Antioch Fire Protection District. The Lake County ETSB has also agreed to opt out E911 wireline calls originating from the Village of Lake Villa and the Village of Lindenhurst as well as the Lake Villa Fire Protection District to the Village of Fox Lake ETSB (FoxComm). Village of Fox Lake ETSB will also be filing a modification in order to opt in the E911 wireline calls originating from the Village of Lake Villa, the Village of Lindenhurst and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District.

An Agreement has been reached between the Lake County ETSB, CenCom and FoxComm. A copy of said Agreement is attached as Exhibit A.

This agreement is necessary because the Village of Antioch is ceasing operation of its PSAP. The Village of Antioch and the Antioch Fire Protection District have contracted with CenCom for Police and Fire Dispatch services. The Village of Antioch is serviced by the Antioch Police Department and the Antioch Fire Protection District. The Village of Lake Villa, Village of Lindenhurst and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District have contracted with FoxComm for Police and Fire Dispatch services. The Village of Lake Villa is serviced by the Lake Villa Police Department and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District. The Village of Lindenhurst is serviced by the Lindenhurst Police Department and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District.

The Antioch PSAP serves as a back up to the Lake County Sheriff's PSAP for all landline calls north of R. 120. The Wauconda PSAP will now serve as the backup for all Lake County Sheriff's PSAP landline calls.

The Village of Antioch, and the Antioch Fire Protection District, its wireline fire, EMS, and police emergencies will be dispatched by CenCom, and unincorporated police emergencies will be transferred by CenCom to the Lake County Sheriff's PSAP for dispatch. A Call Handling Agreement between the Village of Antioch, Antioch Fire Protection District and the Lake County Sheriff's PSAP has already been approved by all entities.

The Village of Lake Villa, the Village of Lindenhurst and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District, its wireline calls for fire, EMS, and police emergencies will be dispatched by FoxComm and unincorporated police emergencies will be transferred by FoxComm to the Lake County Sheriff's PSAP for dispatch. A Call Handling Agreement between the Village of Lake Villa, Village of Lindenhurst, Lake Villa Fire Protection District and the Lake County Sheriff's PSAP has already been approved by all entities.

Even after ICC approval of the plan modification, and pursuant to Illinois statute, the Lake County ETSB will continue to collect the \$.75 surcharge for the Village of Antioch and the Antioch Fire Protection District, the Village of Lake Villa, Village of Lindenhurst and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District residents.


Jurisdiction: Village of Antioch, Antioch Fire Protection District, Village of Lake Villa, Village of Lindenhurst and Lake Villa Fire Protection District.

Under the existing Lake County Emergency Telephone System Board (LCETSB) 9-1-1 ESN Routing plan, as filed with and approved by the Illinois Commerce Commission on November 9, 1992, all 9-1-1 land-line calls from the Village of Antioch, Antioch Fire Protection District, Village of Lake Villa, Village of Lindenhurst and Lake Villa Fire Protection District are answered by the Antioch PSAP. Calls for police assistance are dispatched directly to Antioch police. Calls for fire and rescue are directly dispatched to Antioch Fire Protection District. Calls for Lake County Sheriff's Department are transferred to the Lake County Sheriff's PSAP for police dispatch.

With this agreement 911 ESN routing will be changed. All 9-1-1 land-line calls within the Village of Antioch and Antioch Fire Protection District will be automatically routed to CenCom. Police calls will be dispatched by CenCom directly to the Antioch Police Department units. The 9-1-1 calls for fire and rescue within the Antioch Fire Protection District will be dispatched by CenCom directly to the Antioch Fire Protection District units. The 9-1-1 calls for the Lake County Sheriff's Department will be transferred by CenCom to the Lake County Sheriff's Department PSAP for police dispatch. All 9-1-1 land-line calls within the Village of Lake Villa, Village of Lindenhurst and Lake Villa Fire Protection District will be automatically routed to FoxComm. Police calls will be dispatched by FoxComm directly to the Lake Villa Police Department units and Lindenhurst Police Department units. The 9-1-1 calls for fire and rescue within the Lake Villa Fire Protection District will be dispatched by FoxComm directly to the Lake Villa Fire Protection District units. The 9-1-1 calls for the Lake County Sheriff's Department will be transferred by FoxComm to the Lake County Sheriff's Department PSAP for police dispatch.

These call routing changes will be effected immediately upon approval of the Illinois Commerce Commission (the ICC).

Either CenCom Joint ETSB, Village of Fox Lake ETSB or the Lake County ETSB may terminate this agreement at any time with 120 (One hundred twenty) days written notice to the other parties.

## AGREEMENT ON 9-1-1 CALL HANDLING AND ROUTING

This Agreement, which relates to 9-1-1 call routing, is between the LAKE COUNTY ETSB, an agency of the County of Lake, Fox Lake ETSB (FoxComm), an agency of the Village of Fox Lake, and the CENCOM E9-1-1 PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS CENTER, an agency created through an intergovernmental agreement signed by the Greater Round Lake Fire Protection District, the Round Lake Area Park District, and the villages of Barrington, Hainesville, Round Lake, Round Lake Beach, Round Lake Heights, and Round Lake Park (CenCom). The Agreement will become effective when all the parties have signed it, and the date this Agreement is signed by the last party to sign it (as indicated by the date associated with that party's signature) will be deemed the date of this agreement.

### Recitals

#### WHEREAS:

- the Emergency Telephone System Act, 50 ILCS 750/0.01 *et seq.* ("Act"), authorizes units of local government to own and operate emergency telephone systems, and to establish Emergency Telephone System Boards, and both the County of Lake and the Village of Fox Lake own and operate ETSBs; and
- section 15.4 of the Act also authorizes municipalities to establish, by intergovernmental agreement, a Joint Emergency Telephone System Board, and CenCom is governed by such a Board; and
- section 14 of the Act provides for joint powers agreements or other written cooperative agreements between public agencies and public safety agencies that are part of different systems but whose jurisdictional boundaries are contiguous; and
- the Lake County ETSB, as originally established, has had a public safety answering point in Antioch (the "Antioch PSAP"), which has landline 9-1-1 call handling capabilities and which dispatches emergency services by means of the Police and Fire Departments for the villages of Antioch, Lindenhurst, and Lake Villa; and
- the Lake County ETSB routes 9-1-1 calls based on Fire Protection Districts, and such calls will, at times, be received by one Party that originate within the police jurisdiction of another Party; and
- the Antioch Village Board voted on April 16, 2012, to close the Antioch PSAP during the timeframe of August 15–September 15, 2012; and
- Antioch has contracted with CenCom to provide the dispatching service previously supplied by the Antioch PSAP; and
- Lake Villa, Lindenhurst and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District have contracted with FoxComm to provide the dispatching service previously supplied by the Antioch PSAP; and

- Antioch, Lake Villa, Lindenhurst, the Lake Villa Fire Protection District and the Antioch Fire Protection District will continue to be part of the Lake County ETSB; and
- to facilitate the transfer of service from the Antioch PSAP to CenCom and FoxComm, and to ensure reliable and efficient call routing, CenCom, FoxComm and the Lake County ETSB wish to enter into a call handling and call routing agreement whereby CenCom agrees to handle landline 9-1-1 calls arising within the jurisdictions comprising the Village of Antioch and the Antioch Fire Protection District, and FoxComm agrees to handle landline 9-1-1 calls, arising within the jurisdictions comprising the Village of Lake Villa, the Village of Lindenhurst and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District, and to route such calls to the appropriate public safety answering point for appropriate response, including emergency dispatch response.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Lake County ETSB agrees to opt out of receiving landline E9-1-1 calls originating from within the Antioch Fire Protection District and the Lake Villa Fire Protection District, and to effect that change, it will file an Illinois Commerce Commission Plan Modification prior to August 1, 2012.

2. CenCom and FoxComm agree to receive landline E9-1-1 calls originating from within the Antioch Fire Protection District and Lake Villa Fire Protection District, and to effect that change, they will also file an Illinois Commerce Commission Plan Modification prior to August 1, 2012.

3. The plan modifications the parties will submit to the Illinois Commerce Commission will ask for the Commission's approval to change the 911 ESN routing as follows:

- a. All landline calls within the Village of Antioch shall be routed to CenCom;
- b. All landline calls within the Antioch Fire Protection District shall be routed to CenCom.
- c. All landline calls within the Village of Lake Villa and the Village of Lindenhurst shall be routed to FoxComm;
- d. All landline calls within the Lake Villa Fire Protection District shall be routed to FoxComm.

4. CenCom and FoxComm agree to route police emergencies located in unincorporated areas of Lake County to the Lake County Sheriff's PSAP for dispatch.

5. The plan modifications will not alter the current or future collection of E9-1-1 surcharge within the Lake County ETSB, CenCom or FoxComm E9-1-1 jurisdictions and only relate to call routing.


