Lopa Banerjee, Director of Pricing and Portfolio

Lopa Banerjee joined Green Mountain in 2006 as Manager of Pricing and Portfolio. Her duties have included: (i) ERCOT trading, since 2006; (ii) PJM scheduling for Green Mountain (a PJM member) for a wind farm, since 2006; and (iii) NYISO trading and scheduling, since the third quarter of 2009. From 2003 through 2005, Lopa was Senior Trader in ERCOT for First Choice Power. In 2002, Lopa was a Trader/mid-marketer in PJM, NEPOOL, ComEd (now Midwest ISO) and ERCOT, for El Paso Energy. Lopa has been buying and selling power and energy in wholesale markets since 2002 and has been scheduling PJM for Green Mountain (a PJM member) since 2006.

Kerrie Hlavaty, Manager of Pricing and Portfolio

Kerrie Hlavaty has been Manager of Pricing and Portfolio for Green Mountain Energy Company since the first quarter of 2012, where her duties have included: (i) ERCOT trading; (ii) PJM scheduling for Green Mountain (a PJM member); and (iii) NYISO trading and scheduling. From 1999 through 2009, Kerrie held several positions in the Northeast and ERCOT, for Reliant Energy/Noram Energy: ERCOT Supply Director of Portfolio Optimization from 2008 to 2009; Director of Real-time Operations from 2006 to 2008; Manager, Asset Commercialization from 2001 to 2006; and Northeast Power Trader from 1999 to 2000. From 1997 to 1999, Kerrie worked for Duke Energy Trading and Marketing Company, where she scheduled power across the U.S., including PJM, NEPOOL, ComEd (now Midwest ISO), ECAR, TVA, SERC and ERCOT, as well as traded short-term power mainly in NEPOOL and PJM. Kerrie has more than 13 years of experience in the power industry buying, selling, managing portfolios and scheduling power in wholesale markets.

Green Mountain and NRG Power Marketing LLC are both wholly-owned subsidiaries of NRG Energy, Inc. Both are members of PJM. In addition to its own staff, Green Mountain will also rely on the technical capabilities of other wholly-owned affiliates of NRG Energy, Inc.

Tom Wettlaufer attended North Dakota State College of Science. His career in the power business began in 1979 as a Power System Operation. Tom is currently NRG's PJM Portfolio Director, a position he has held since January 2009. In this capacity, Tom is responsible for managing the commodity price risk of the PJM fleet and directing the day-to-day management of NRG's PJM generation portfolio and load obligations. His experience in these areas has included all areas of the Eastern Interconnection.

Alex LaGuardia attended Rutgers University and has been employed in the power marketing business since 1999. Alex is currently the PJM Asset Manager, a position he has held since July 2006. Alex is responsible for the day-to-day management of NRG's PJM generation portfolio and load obligations, which include but are not limited to day ahead scheduling, outage management, RPS management and bill reconciliation. His experience in these areas has been limited to the PJM footprint to date.
