DEAR JUDGE HAYNES :

I STARTED THE ACTION IN JANUARY 1983 THAT LED TO THE COMPLAINT BEING NEGOTIATED BETWEEN "THE MANORS OF HIGHLAND PARK" AND "COMMONWEALTH EDISON".

UPON MOVING IN TO MY UNIT HERE IN HIGHLAND PARK, I NOTICED THAT THE PUBLIC HALLS IN THE FOUR EXISTING BUILDINGS WERE HEATED ELECTRICALLY. BEING AN ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR, I KNEW THAT IN ORDER TO GET THE SPECIAL RATE OFFERED BY EDISON, THAT THE ELECTRIC HEAT USAGE HAD TO BE METERED SEPARATELY. I FOUND THAT THIS WAS NOT SO.

I DISCUSSED THIS WITH THE MANAGEMENT BOARD AND THEN CONTACTED MR. RAYMOND HODOWOLD, MARKETING REPRESENTATIVE OF COMMONWEALTH EDISON IN THIS AREA. AS THE EXISTING METERING WAS LOCATED ON THE OUTSIDE OF THE BUILDINGS AS IT WAS IMPOSSIBLE TO ADD AN ELECTRIC HEAT METER TO THE EXISTING OUTSIDE METERS. WE DECIDED THAT THE ADDITIONAL METER WOULD HAVE TO BE INSTALLED IN THE ELECTRIC CLOSET. IT WOULD HAVE TO BE METERED AND BILLED SEPARATELY, BUT AS THE OUTSIDE PUBLIC HALL ALREADY CONTAINED THE ELECTRIC LOAD, THE ELECTRIC HEAT LOAD WOULD HAVE TO BE SUBTRACTED FROM THE PUBLIC METER. THIS WOULD BE CALLED A SUBTRACTIVE METER OR A REMOTE METER.

METER RENTAL. EDISON SHOULD REFUND THE DOUBLED LIGHT LOAD AND THE METER RENTAL AS THEY WERE NOT BILLING IT PROPERLY. THE COST OF LABOR AND MATERIALS SHOULD ALSO BE REFUNDED BECAUSE THE COSTS WERE EXPENDED FOR READINGS THAT WERE NOT BILLED PROPERLY. EDISON IS TRYING TO REIMBURSE FOR ONLY A FEW YEARS RATHER THAN FOR THE ENTIRE PERIOD.

I SIGNED SIGNED A DOCUMENT LETTING THE MANORS IN TO THE HEARINGS, I WOULD NOW LIKE TO CANCEL THIS AUTHORIZATION. IF IT HADN'T BEEN FOR ME EDISON WOULD STILL BE OVER-BILLING THE MANORS. THEY ARE ATTEMPTING TO PUSH ME OUT OF THE NEGOTIATIONS AND THE HEARINGS. I BELIEVE I CAN WORK WITH EDISON WITHOUT ANY HELP FROM THE MANORS BOARD.

LETS PROCEED TO GET EDISON ON THE TRACK AND GET THE PROPER AMOUNT OF MONEY REFUNDED. WITH THE PROPER REFUNDS, WE WILL PROBABLY BE ABLE TO AVOID INCREASES IN ASSESSMENTS.

LETS GET THE MANORS RUNNING PROPERLY. REPECTFULLY. I REMAIN DEDICATED TO OBTAINING THE PROPER MONIES BACK.
