APPLICATION

NOW COMES TelecomEZ Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Early, Lennon, Crocker & Bartosiewicz, P.L.C. and pursuant to Article XIII of the Illinois Public Utilities Act, makes this Application to the Illinois Commerce Commission (hereinafter referred to as "Commission") for a Certificate of Interexchange Service Authority to provide competitive interexchange telecommunications service within the State of Illinois. In support of its Application, Applicant provides the following information:

3. Applicant is incorporated under the laws of Colorado, currently engaged in the business of reselling interexchange telecommunications services. A copy of Applicant's Articles of Incorporation is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. Applicant has the authority to transact business within the State of Illinois as a foreign corporation. A copy of the qualifying document is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**.

4. Applicant's current corporate officers are as follows:

5. Applicant also requests that the Commission exempt Applicant from the provisions of Article I-XII of the Illinois Public Utilities Act, and to treat Applicant as a competitive long distance carrier.

6. Applicant has sufficient technical, financial, and managerial resources and ability to provide interexchange telecommunications services as required pursuant to Article XIII, Sec. 13-403 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act.

7. In support of Applicant's technical, financial, and managerial resources and ability, Applicant submits a description of the background and experience of Applicant's management personnel as **Exhibit C**. A copy of Applicant's most recent financial statements are attached as **Exhibit D**.

8. Applicant seeks to provide 24 hours per day telecommunications services from certain points of origin in Illinois to destination points in Illinois, and interstate services between origin points within the state of Illinois to all points in the contiguous United States, Alaska, Hawaii and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

10. Applicant submits the following reasons in support of its belief that the public interest will be served by the approval of this application:

(a) Applicant's proposed service will use existing telecommunications facilities more efficiently;

(b) The principle of competition within the Illinois telecommunications market will bring long term benefits to the Illinois end users, including, but not limited to, the following:

(i) Expanded market coverage enriched by existing carrier sales forces;

(ii) High quality alternative telecommunications services;

(iii) Increased consumer choices in billing options;

(iv) Efficient use of existing telecommunications resources as well as increased diversification and increased reliability of the supply of the telecommunications services;

(v) An expanded telecommunications industry in Illinois with attendant employment opportunities for Illinois residents; and,


(vi) An additional tax revenue source for the State of Illinois.

11. Applicant is prepared to give a copy of this Application to any potential competitor, governmental entity, or interested party requesting a copy, and to any persons that the Commission directs by order or by its rules.

WHEREFORE, TelecomEZ Corporation respectfully requests that the Illinois Commerce Commission:


- (a) Grant Applicant a Certificate of Interexchange Service Authority to provide competitive telecommunications service within the State of Illinois;




