**PROPOSED ORDER**

By the Commission:

On September 10, 2012, MRDB Holdings LP (“MRDB”) filed a verified petition with the Illinois Commerce Commission (“Commission”) requesting an order cancelling its Certificate of Service Authority authorizing it to operate as an agent, broker, or consultant (“ABC”) in Illinois pursuant to Section 16-115C of the Public Utilities Act, 220 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 454, "Licensure of Retail Electric Agents, Brokers and Consultants" (“Part 454”). MRDB received its Certificate of Service Authority on January 12, 2010 in Docket No. 09-0533. MRDB reports that as January 31, 2012, substantially all of its assets and liabilities were acquired by Ecova, Inc., another licensed ABC in Illinois. Ecova, Inc. received its Certificate of Service Authority on May 4, 2011 under the name of Advantage IQ, Inc. in Docket No. 11-0297. Commission records reflect that Advantage IQ, Inc. changed its name to Ecova, Inc. on November 18, 2011. MRDB reports that all of its customers have been transitioned to Ecova, Inc.

The Commission has reviewed the petition and concurs with MRDB's assertion that it has filed its 2011 Part 454 report with the Chief Clerk's Office. Although MRDB states that its 2012 information will be reflected in Ecova, Inc.'s 2012 Part 454 report, the Commission prefers that MRDB file its 2012 information under its own name. Requiring such will preserve the clarity of the Commission's records and is consistent with the reporting requirements of Part 454. The Commission also finds that those requirements in Part 454 that relate to the maintenance of records for a specified period and the confidentiality of customers' data should continue to apply. The Commission concludes, therefore, that MRDB's Certificate of Service Authority should be cancelled subject to such conditions. A Proposed Order containing the conditions was served on MRDB.

The Commission, having reviewed the entire record, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) MRDB received authority to operate as an ABC in Docket No. 09-0533 and now seeks to relinquish that authority;

- (2) the Commission has jurisdiction over the party hereto and the subject matter hereof;
- (3) the recitals of fact and conclusions reached in the prefatory portion of this Order are supported by the record and are hereby adopted as findings of fact; and
- (4) the Certificate of Service Authority granted to MRDB should be permanently cancelled subject to the conditions that (a) MRDB continue to comply with Section 454.90(h) and (j) and Section 454.100 of Part 454 and (b) MDRB file its final report pursuant to Section 454.110 of Part 454 within 15 calendar days of the entry of this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Illinois Commerce Commission that the Certificate of Service Authority granted to MRDB Holdings LP in Docket No. 09-0533 is hereby cancelled subject to the conditions in Finding (4).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Illinois Commerce Commission retains jurisdiction over this matter to ensure compliance with the conditions in Finding (4).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, subject to the provisions of Section 10-113 of the Public Utilities Act and 83 Ill. Adm. Code 200.880, this Order is final; it is not subject to the Administrative Review Law.
