PETITION


Now comes the County of Edwards, Illinois, and requests Illinois Commerce Commission approval of its Final Plan to establish an emergency telephone number system and in support thereof states as follows:

1. Attached hereto and incorporated herein as though fully set forth is the Final Plan for the County of Edwards, "9-1-1" Emergency Telephone Number System.
2. A duplicate original of said Final Plan has been filed by mail with the Frontier Telephone Company, Wabash Telephone Company, and New Wave/Big River Telephone Company.
3. The Final Plan is intended to comply with the terms and provisions of "An Act in relation to the designation of an emergency telephone number for use throughout the State."

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner, the County of Edwards, Illinois, a municipal corporation, prays that the Illinois Commerce commission:

- (1) give notice of and conduct a public hearing on this Petition and Final Plan at the earliest possible date;
- (2) enter an Order approving the Final Plan submitted herewith and authorizing the implementation of the 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System described herein.
