5 that the commission can put this amendment on the  
6 commission website. In view of that, I will identify  
7 the verified statement of A. Olusanjo Omoniyi as  
8 found on the commission e-docket as Staff Exhibit 1  
9 and move that it be admitted into record evidence. I  
10 note for the record, that it was filed on September  
11 27, 2012, at 9:15 a.m. The tracking number is  
12 142905. Thank you.
