RESPONSE BY MARY SPLAIN , MORGAN COUNTY LANDOWNER, TO  
PETITION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

MARY SPLAIN, Morgan County landowner, by her attorney, G. Ronald Kesinger, for response to Petition for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity filed by AMEREN TRANSMISSION COMPANY OF ILLINOIS, states as follows:

1. That MARY SPLAIN is the owner of five (5) acres of land in Morgan County, Illinois, more particularly described as follows:  
The North half (N ½ )of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (NE¼) of the Northeast quarter (NE ¼ ) of Section Thirty-Four (34) in Township Sixteen (16) North in Range Eleven (11) West of the Third Principal Meridian, Morgan County, Illinois.

and that she has a residence, outbuildings, stables and four horses, located thereon, as shown by Exhibit A. (Red Rectangle).

2. That she objects to the location of the utility poles, and/or transmission line in Section 26 and 27 of Township 16 North Range 11 West of the Third Principal Meridian, Morgan County, Illinois, wherein her residential real estate is located.

3. That the location of the proposed transmission lines would be directly on or in front of her land which would greatly compromise and impair the use of her land esthetically, visually and physically.

4. That she proposes that Petitioner, AMEREN TRANSMISSION COMPANY OF ILLINOIS, instead install transmission lines by turning north at the approximate midpoint of the Southerly side of Section 27 and thence traveling North along Concord Road and thereafter continuing North to the south side of an existing transmission line and thence turning East to a point where the proposed route continue eastward in Sec. 26 as more particularly shown on Exhibit A attached hereto (in red).

5. That said proposed change would avoid interfering with the use of land of MARY SPLAIN as well as land owned by Paul D. and Michelle Muller and David Englebrecht in Section 27 and 26, respectively.

WHEREFORE, MARY SPLAIN prays that the route of the transmission line be modified as herein stated.
