PETITION TO INTERVENE

NOW COMES Janet Roney, Moultrie County landowner, to petition to intervene and be made an active party in the above captioned proceeding, pursuant to the Rules of Practice of the Illinois Commerce Commission, 83 ILL. Adm Code Sect. 200.200. In support thereof, Janet S. Roney states as follows:

1. The petitioner, Janet Roney, is a landowner of one hundred and sixty-six (166) acres of land located in Section 15, T14, R5E of the north part of Sullivan Township and Section 10, T14, R5 of the south part of Lovington Township, Moultrie County, IL, which the proposed primary route of the Illinois Rivers Transmission project crosses on the east/west line between Lovington and Sullivan Townships. 
2. The petitioner offers an alternative route (blue line in Exhibit A) that
 - a. reduces Ameren's expense, because it is shorter,
 - b. moves the transmission line farther away from three of her neighbor's residences, (purple squares in Exhibit A)
 - c. moves transmission poles to property lines rather than on tillable soil (Exhibit A),
 - d. routes the transmission line off of the land of seven neighbors, (Exhibit B)
 - e. affects only landowners who have been notified previously by Ameren Transmission Company of their land's involvement in the project. (Exhibit B)
 - f. preserves the integrity and leaves undisturbed a 10,000 year old native prairie remnant, which has been privately maintained for fifty years and which contains at least fifty identifiable species of native prairie grasses and flora, (green dashes in Exhibit A and photo in Exhibit C)
3. That the location of her alternative route would eliminate the right angle turn of Ameren's primary route located on her property in section 15, T14N, R5E or east of her property in section 14, T14, R5E and replace it with an angled route utilizing the stair-step boundary line between her property and that of the adjoining landowners. (See Exhibit A)
4. That the location of the transmission poles could be between 800 and 1000 feet apart on the property line between the petitioner and that of the adjoining land owners instead of in the middle of tillable farmland.
5. The petitioner agrees to accept services by electronic means as provided for in Section 200.1050.
6. The petitioner asks leave to intervene and be treated as a party to the proceeding.
