NOW COMES the Complainant, JAMAL SHEHADEH pro se, and for his Docketing Statement pursuant to S. Ct. Rule 312, does state the following:

(1) This matter is not now nor has it ever been pending before this Court;

(4) Complainant estimates the report of proceedings to be less than 100 pages, however, Complainant will not be requesting that they be prepared as all relevant matters to this Appeal are part of the common law record;

(5) The nature of this Appeal is the Illinois Commerce Commission's dismissal of Complainant's complaint against Consolidated Communications Public Services, a telecommunications carrier and the vendor contracted with the State of Illinois to service the Illinois Department of Corrections' offender telephone system;

(6) Some of the primary issues proposed to be raised on Appeal are:

- a.) Whether a service contract made part of a utility's tariff has the full force and effect of the tariff, the terms of which can be enforced by the Commission;
- b.) Whether Respondent's tariff on file with the Commission can be enforced by offenders committed to the custody of the Illinois Department of Corrections;
- c.) Whether Complainant has standing to seek reparations for dropped calls made on Consolidated's equipment that was not maintained in accordance with the terms of its State contract;

(7) On October 17, 2012 an order was entered by the Commission dismissing Complainant's complaint. The Order was served on the Complainant on or about November 21, 2012. Complainant filed his Petition for Rehearing pursuant to 83 Ill. Ad. Code 200.880(a) on December 3, 2012. The Commission failed to serve Complainant with a copy of its Order within 20 days thereafter as required by 20 Ill. Ad. Code 200.880(d). This Petition for Review was filed within 30 days after the Commission's Order was due;

(8) On December 27, 2012 Complainant mailed a letter to the Clerk of the Illinois Commerce Commission and requested that she prepare, certify, and transmit the common law record to this Court.


