The People of the State of Illinois, *ex rel.* James E. Ryan, Attorney General of the State of Illinois, (“the People”) pursuant to the Rules of Practice of the Illinois Commerce Commission, 83 Ill.Admin.Code, Section 200.200, petition for leave to intervene and be made a party in the above captioned proceeding. In support of this Petition, the People of the State of Illinois state the following:

1. This docket is a suspension of tariffs filed by North Shore Gas to implement a small volume customer transportation that would be available to all small volume commercial customers and to small volume residential customers.
2. The Attorney General represents consumers of North Shore Gas and potential participants in North Shore’s “Choices For You” Pilot Program.
3. The Attorney General has an interest in ensuring that the North Shore Pilot Program meets the Public Interest Standards and other requirements set forth in the Public Utilities Act.
4. The People of the State of Illinois, as consumers of Gas, will be affected by any order entered by the Commission in this proceeding.
5. The People accept the record as of this date.

WHEREFORE, for the above-stated reasons, the People pray that leave to intervene be granted by the Commission and that they be made a party to the proceedings in Docket No. 01-0469.
