LAURA TE GROTENHUIS' ALTERNATE ROUTE PROPOSAL

Laura Te Grotenhuis, by and through her attorneys, Hinshaw & Culbertson LLP, hereby submit her proposed alternative route for the 345 kW transmission line proposed by Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois ("ATXI") in the above-referenced proceeding. In support of the alternate route, Laura Te Grotenhuis states:

1. Ms. Te Grotenhuis has identified significant issues associated with ATXI's primary route for the transmission line, and has identified a potential route for the transmission line that addresses those issues. Accordingly, Ms. Te Grotenhuis is submitting the instant filing with a map and property owner information.

2. This alternate route uses Ameren's primary transmission line that travels east from the Kansas substation into Section 35 of Township 11N, Range 12W of Marshall Township. The alternative route would travel south 150 feet along the division of sections 35 and 36, then travel east through Section 36 and continue east to the northwest quarter of Section 36. The alternate route would then travel north along a 90 degree line back to the primary route.

3. This alternate route would require a very small amount of new right of way that would need to be obtained from landowners not previously identified as an affected landowner in this proceeding.

4. In the event the ALJs and the Commission find that ATXI's routes should not be utilized, Ms. Te Grotenhuis proposes her Alternate Route depicted on the attached Exhibit A. The names and addresses of the landowners that would be impacted by Ms. Grotenhuis' Alternate Route are listed on the attached Exhibit B.

WHEREFORE, Ms. Te Grotenhuis prays that the Commission reject ATXI's proposed routes and approve her Alternate Route proposed in this motion and depicted on Exhibit A
