PETITION

NOW COMES T-NETIX Telecommunications Services, Inc. ("T-NETIX Telecom" or "Company") and petitions this Honorable Commission for withdrawal of its Certificate of Authority to provide public pay telephone services through the resale of local exchange and interexchange services from public locations in the State of Illinois ("public pay telephone services"). In support of this Petition, T-NETIX Telecom states as follows:

1. T-NETIX Telecom was authorized to provide public pay telephone services pursuant to this Commission's Order in Docket No. 92-0326.

2. In the same Order, the Commission authorized T-NETIX Telecom to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services for prisoners in detention and correctional facilities within the State of Illinois ("inmate telephone services").

3. In Docket No. 11-0215, by Order dated June 14, 2011, the Commission granted a T-NETIX Telecom Petition, filed March 4, 2011, to withdraw its "Certificate of Interexchange Service Authority granted in Docket No. 92-0326" and to cancel T-NETIX Telecom's Illinois C.C. Tariff No. 1 and Illinois C.C. Tariff No. 3. See attached Order. The Company intended that its

authorizations for both public pay telephone and inmate telephone services be withdrawn and cancelled.

4. However, on or about February 8, 2013, T-NETIX Telecom was informed by the Commission Staff that in fact its authorization to provide public pay telephone services had not been withdrawn and the Company was still so authorized by the Commission. By this Petition T-NETIX Telecom seeks and requests to withdraw and cancel that authorization.

5. As a result of the natural attrition of customers, T-NETIX Telecom currently has (and has had) no public pay telephone services customers in the State of Illinois. Accordingly, no customers exist to whom notice of discontinuance of services might be served. T-NETIX Telecom therefore respectfully requests that the Notice of Discontinuance required by Section 13-406 of the Public Utilities Act be waived.

6. T-NETIX Telecom further requests that since no parties will be prejudiced by the grant of this Petition the requirement for any hearing be waived or in the alternative any such hearing be held on a telephonic basis.

WHEREFORE, T-NETIX Telecommunications Services, Inc. respectfully requests that this Honorable Commission:

A. Grant its Petition for Withdrawal of Certificate of Authority to Provide Public Pay Telephone Services granted in Docket No. 92-0326;

B. Grant its request for waiver of the Notice of Discontinuance required by Section 13-406 of the Public Utilities Act;

D. Grant its request for waiver of a requirement for any hearing or in the alternative that any hearing be held telephonically; and

E. Grant any other appropriate relief consistent with the foregoing requests.


