For over 40 years, LAF has provided poor people across the Chicago metropolitan area with free, professional legal services. Each year, LAF makes equal justice a reality for over 60,000 of the most vulnerable people in our community.

Each issue is unique, and each of LAF's full-time attorneys and staff give their clients individualized attention. Their work results in such successes as the custody of a child, an order of protection from an abusive spouse, prevention of an unfair eviction, or justice for a victim of consumer fraud. LAF's work starts by making the legal system accessible to clients and concludes with a resolution that changes their lives and gets them back on track.

With the economic downturn, LAF's work is more important than ever. The ranks of Cook County's poor have increased by half a million people in recent years. In that same period of time, LAF has helped over 1,600 families whose homes were in foreclosure. In addition, about 6,400 people avoided homelessness because LAF prevented unfair evictions or the loss of a subsidized housing voucher. Over 67 percent of LAF's clients are women raising children on their own.

Today, governmental budget cuts are deeper than ever. So now, at a critical time when LAF's services are most needed, LAF relies on private donations to fulfill its mission.
